Q & A: LAYING ON OF HANDS and FALSE PROPHETS

And how do you stop ppl from laying hands on you, not knowing what spirit they have? And it is so rude.

ANSWER:

1 Timothy 5:22 - Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep thyself pure.

I feel this scripture is speaking about ordaining someone into the ministry or imparting an anointing to someone before you really know their heart and walk for the Lord. You do not want to seem to bless their sin because God doesn't do that, He is holy.

If you find yourself in a church and you know the minister is not a true minister of the Lord Jesus Christ, then do not go down front for prayer. Do not let that minister lay hands on you. If you know they are false and you go and let them lay hands on you, then it is your free will and you are seeking whatever spirit is on them and you will probably get an impartation of it too.

Now if you are in church and some people approach you in a group and maybe some are not really Christians and you see no fruit, you don't have to be rude to them. God knows about times like that and He protects you by His Holy Spirit. You are not seeking what they have, you just aren't pushing them away. None of us are perfect and there is no need to hurt feelings if we don't have to but we do not go seeking after false spirits and false prophets – we want nothing to do with that stuff. If you are in a false church and Holy Spirit reveals it to you, you need to get out of it.

Ministers often lay hands on people for prayer and not everyone that wants prayer is saved, God protects us.

FALSE PROPHETS

Some of you guys are asking me if this person is false, if that person is false, what about this ministry or that ministry etc.

God has not called me to call out these people. I have seen people do this and I have seen nothing but an ugly argument ensue. This is where you must grow in the Lord and listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit and heed His warning. Study to show yourself approved. When you walk intimately with Jesus you will get a warning of who is a true minister or ministry and who is not.

You will know who is a true minister or ministry by what they say, is it in the Bible, does the Bible agree? We must measure everything against God's Word, it is Life and health to all our flesh.

I used to listen to some false prophets and I learned a lot as a baby Christian, then I grew to the point that I started catching errors in their doctrine. Some of them I totally turned away from. I know God was growing me and teaching me and even using them. God can use anyone, even someone that is not being true to Him. He can speak to you through any means He chooses. But as you grow you will begin to see the things that are not right.

Many times for me when they are strongly opposed to the Lord I cannot even hardly stand to look at them or hear them. My Spirit is that bothered by them. Please know that there are many right now praying in Jesus' name, speaking as if He is Lord of their life and looking just like we would think a minister of God would look and act. However, their heart is not on Jesus and He is not the lord they serve.

- **1 John 4:1** Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- **1 Cor. 12:3** Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and *that* no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

This scripture seems to make no sense because we all know there are so many people right now that say they are Christians and don't even love or serve Jesus. I interpret this scripture to mean in their heart and in truth.

Matt.15:8 - This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with *their* lips; but their heart is far from Me.
