

# DECEPTION of GOD'S NAME – Part One: YHWH, JEHOVAH

We are going to look into where yhwh and jehovah came from and see for ourselves if we believe it is the true sacred name of God the Father.

I have just heard about this in the last few years from preachers on tv. The main two will be revealed in this teaching series. There are people that believe we are to only speak the Hebrew names of God the Father and Jesus Christ. When you find someone teaching that garbage you are usually dealing with a Hebrew Roots person. **1 John 2:23** - Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: *(but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.*

Mary mentioned a Hebrew name for God the Father that I had not heard and so the research for this message began. I researched and prayed and I am going to present what I have found here. This is based on what God said His name is in Exodus 3:14.


First let's go back to the garden. satan's first attack was on the Word of God. hath God said??

**Genesis 3:1** - Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

**Exodus 3:14** - And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and He said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The LORD

God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this *is* My name for ever, and this *is* My memorial unto all generations.

## WIKIPEDIA – I AM THAT I AM

**I Am that I Am** (אֶהְיֶה אֲשֶׁר אֶהְיֶה, ehyeh ašer ehyeh [eh'je a'fer eh'je]) is the common English translation (JPS among others) of the response that God used in the Hebrew Bible when Moses asked for his name (Exodus 3:14). It is one of the most famous verses in the **Torah**.

## EHYEH


It is one of the most famous verses in the Torah. Hayah means "existed" in Hebrew; **Ehyeh** is the first person singular imperfect form and is usually translated in English Bibles as "I Am" or "I will be" (or "I shall be"), for example, at Exodus 3:14. **Ehyeh (pronounced A-hay-ah) asher ehyeh** literally translates as "I Am Who I Am." **So I AM is supposed to be Ehyeh.**

## Tanakh

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The **Tanakh** (/tɑːˈnɑːx/<sup>[1]</sup> Hebrew: תַּנְכַּ"ךְ, pronounced [taˈnax] or [təˈnax]; also *Tenakh*, *Tenak*, *Tanach*) or **Mikra** or Hebrew Bible is the canonical collection of Jewish texts, which is also a textual source for the Christian Old Testament. These texts are composed mainly in Biblical Hebrew, with some passages in Biblical Aramaic (in the books of Daniel, Ezra and a few others). The traditional Hebrew text is known as the Masoretic Text. The Tanakh consists of twenty-four books.

*Tanakh* is an acronym of the first Hebrew letter of each of the Masoretic Text's three traditional subdivisions: Torah ("Teaching", also known as the Five Books of Moses), Nevi'im ("Prophets") and Ketuvim ("Writings")—hence **TaNaKh**. The name "*Mikra*" (מִקְרָא), meaning "that which is read", is another Hebrew word for the *Tanakh*. The books of the Tanakh were passed on by each generation, and according to rabbinic tradition were accompanied by an oral tradition, called the Oral Torah.



saves), a variant of the name of the Lord (I Chron. 7:27 KJV).

**JEHOVAH** (jē-hō'vá), the English rendering of the Hebrew tetragram YHWH, one of the names of God (Exod. 17:15). Its original pronunciation is unknown. The Jews took seriously the third commandment "Thou shalt not take the name of Jehovah thy God in vain; for Jehovah will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain" (Exod. 20:7) and so, to keep from speaking the holy name carelessly, around 300 B.C. they decided not to pronounce it at all; but whenever in reading they came to it they spoke the word *adhonai* which means "Lord." This usage was carried into the LXX where the sacred name is rendered "Kurios," i.e. LORD. Consequently in the KJV, LORD occurs instead of Jehovah, whereas ASV renders the name "Jehovah." When the vowel points were added to the Hebrew consonantal text, the Massoretes (Jewish scribes) inserted into the Hebrew consonantal text the vowels for *adhonai*. The sacred name is derived from the verb "to be," and so implies that God is eternal ("Before Abraham was, I AM") and that he is the Absolute, i.e. the Uncaused One. The name "Jehovah" belongs especially to Him when He is dealing with His own, while "God" is used more when dealing with the Gentiles. See for instance II Chronicles 18:31 where "Jehoshaphat cried out and Jehovah helped him; and God moved them to depart from him."

There are ten combinations of the word "Jehovah" in the OT. Besides the five with which succeeding articles deal, are *Jehovah-ropheka*, "Jehovah that healeth thee" (Exod. 15:26); *Jehovah-neqaddeshkem*, "Jehovah who sanctifieth you"

One thing I want to point out is, that saying God's name is not blaspheming it or Him. He wants an intimate relationship with us. He wants us to call on Him. They learned to be superstitious while in captivity to Babylon and maybe even before that from Egypt. We will go into this later on in this teaching series.




**183.** אָוַה *'avah, aw-vaw'*; a primitive root; to wish for:—covet, (greatly) desire, be desirous, long, lust (after).

**1943.** הִוָּה *hovah, ho-vaw'*; another form for 1942; ruin:—mischief.

**1942.** הַוָּה *havvah, hav-vaw'*; from 1933 (in the sense of eagerly coveting and rushing upon; by implication, of falling); desire; also ruin:—calamity, iniquity, mischief, mischievous (thing), naughtiness, naughty, noisome, perverse thing, substance, very wickedness.

**JEHOSHUA, JEHOSHUAH** (See JOSHUA)

**JEHOVAH.** A misleading representation in English of the only name (as distinct from titles) of God in the OT. Since it is uncertain what vowels should be attached to the Hebrew consonants YHWH that make up the divine name, actual pronunciation must remain hypothetical, but there are reasonable grounds for thinking that the name was Yahweh. At a late date it became a matter of binding scruple not to pronounce the divine name, and Jews (in reading the Scriptures) customarily substituted the noun *adonai*, which means "Lord." LXX followed this lead, using the Greek *kyrios*, "Lord," to stand for the divine name—a significant thing in the light of the usual NT designation of Jesus as *kyrios*. But the formu-

of God doubly certain... rally, the covenant-Redeemer, the God who brought his people out of Egypt (Exod 20:11).  
Two further points must be mentioned. First, in the light of the total biblical revelation in the Old and New Testaments, the name Yahweh is not to be identified only with God the Father, but rather with the Holy Trinity. The way OT passages are made to refer alike to Father, Son, and Holy Spirit demonstrates this; and we should always beware of cramping our theological understanding by thinking of the God of the OT simply as God the Father—while at the same time recognizing that the doctrine of the Holy Trinity, while latent in the OT, is not discoverable there without the definitive revelation of the NT. Second, our English Bibles generally (the Jerusalem Bible is an exception) follow the scruple that avoids using the divine name. Printers have agreed on the convention that Yahweh is represented by the word "LORD"—in caps and small caps. When *adonai* is used independently and in its own right in the OT as a divine title, it appears as "Lord."


**YARN** (Heb. *miqweh*). The Hebrew word that occurs in 1 Kings 10:28 and 2 Chronicles 1:16. In each of these cases "linen yarn" seems to convey the wrong meaning. It is correctly translated in RSV and NIV by the proper name "Kue," the old Assyrian name given to Cilicia, the land located in the SE portion of Asia Minor.


**YEAR** (See CALENDAR)

**YEARLING** (See ANIMALS)

**YHWH.** This is not in reality a word but is known as the "Tetragrammaton," the four consonants standing for the ancient Hebrew name for God commonly referred to as "Jehovah" or "Yahweh." The original Hebrew text was not vocalized. YHWH was considered too sacred to pronounce, so *'adonai* ("my Lord") was substituted in reading. When eventually a vowel system was invented, since the Hebrews had forgotten how to pronounce YHWH, they substituted the vowels for *'adonai*, making "Jehovah," a form first attested at beginning of the twelfth century A.D.

Very important to realize that they had forgotten how to pronounce His name. So they just substituted vowels from Adonai to make a word up and say that is His name. Jehovah was FIRST ATTESTED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE 12<sup>TH</sup> CENTURY.





Go four lines up and read from right to left. Where you see I AM look just above it and you will see it written in Hebrew with strong's reference 1961 written above it. It is written three times: once on the forth line from the bottom and twice on the third line from the bottom.

## The Name of Yahweh in Genesis



*God didn't reveal His personal Name until Exodus.  
So why is the Name of Yahweh showing up in Genesis?*

**Exodus 6:3** - And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by *the name of God Almighty*, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.

**Genesis 22:14** - And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said *to this day*, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

**FOLLOWING I HAVE INCLUDED ALL THE REFERENCES IN STRONG'S TO GOD THE FATHER'S NAME: (1961, 3068 AND 3050 SEEM TO BE THE MOST RELEVANT TO THIS TEACHING)**

**1961.** הָיָה **hayah**, *haw-yaw*; a primitive root (compare 1933); to exist, i.e. be or become, come to pass (always emphatic, and not a mere copula or auxiliary):—beacon, x altogether, be(-come), accomplished, committed, like), break, cause, come (to pass), do, faint, fall, + follow, happen, x have, last, pertain, quit (one-)self, require, x use. **(This is from Exodus 3:14 where God says I AM that I AM)**

**1933.** הָוָה **hava'**, *haw-vaw'*; or הָוָה **havah**, *haw-vaw'*; a primitive root (compare 183, 1961) supposed to mean properly, to breathe; to be (in the sense of existence):—be, x have.

**183.** אָוָה **'avah**, *aw-vaw'*; a primitive root; to wish for:—covet, (greatly) desire, be desirous, long, lust (after).

**3068.** יהוה **Yhwh**; from 1961; (the) self-Existent or Eternal; name of God:—the Lord. Compare 3050, 3069. Judges 2:11 – an example where it only says now LORD (Judges 2:11-12 – one place that talks of the Israelites serving baalim) **JEWISH NATIONAL NAME OF GOD – \*\*That doesn't mean it is the Jews that Love the FATHER. \*\***

**3050.** יה **Yahh**, *yaw*; contraction for 3068, and meaning the same; Jah, the sacred name:—Jah, the Lord, most vehement. Compare names in "-iah," "-jah."

**3069.** יהוה **Yhwh**; a variation of 3068 (used after Adonay -136, and pronounced as elohiym -430, in order to prevent the repetition of the same sound, since elsewhere 3068 is pronounced as 136):—God.

**136.** אֲדֹנָי **Adonay**, *ad-o-noy*; an emphatic form of 113; the Lord (used as a proper name of God only):—(my) Lord.

**430.** אֱלֹהִים **elohiym**, *el-o-heem*; plural of 433; gods in the ordinary sense; but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme God; occasionally applied by way of deference to magistrates; and sometimes as a superlative:—angels, x exceeding, God (gods)(-dess, -ly), x (very) great, judges, x mighty.

**433.** אֱלֹהֵי **elowahh**, *el-o'-ah*; rarely (shortened) אֱלֹהֶיךָ **eloahh**, *el-o'-ah* } probably prolonged (*emphat.*) from 410; a deity or the Deity:—God, god. See 430.

**410.** אֵל **el**, *ale*; shortened from 352; strength; as adjective, mighty; especially the Almighty (but used also of any deity):—God (god), x goodly, x great, idol, might(-y one), power, strong. Compare names in "-el."

**352.** אַיִל **ayil**, *ah'-yil*; from the same as 193; properly, strength; hence, anything strong; specifically a chief (politically); also a ram (from his strength); a pilaster (as a strong support); an oak or other strong tree:—mighty (man), lintel, oak, post, ram, tree.

**193.** אָוִל **uwl**, *ool*; from an unused root meaning to twist, i.e. (by implication) be strong; the body (as being rolled together); also powerful:—mighty, strength.

## CLOSING

After arresting him, he put him in prison, handing him over to be guarded by four squads of four soldiers each. Herod intended to bring him out for public trial after the Passover.


#### [King James Bible](#)

The NIV is a bible version supported by the catholic church and is very corrupt. Yet here in this scripture they used the word Passover and not easter which is a name of one of their gods. This is to make the KJV look untrustworthy. It is still the best translation that we have and the closest to the original Hebrew texts.

Strong's **3957**. **πάσχα pascha**, *pas'-kha*; of Chaldee origin (compare H6453); the Passover (the meal, the day, the festival or the special sacrifices connected with it): — Easter, Passover.

Why would this word pascha be of chaldee origin? They certainly did not serve the Lord God Almighty. They list easter and Passover here as the same thing for a purpose. To drive an agenda to confuse new Christians and those who are after the truth. These two words are not interchangeable, they do not speak of the same event.



I asked Scott why he never said yahweh or Yeshua and he said because he doesn't speak Hebrew and he isn't trying to impress anyone.

For me I wanted to be able to call Him by His Hebrew name. When Paul met Jesus on his way to Damascus, Jesus spoke Hebrew to Him. I believed these teachings but God has been growing me up and especially in the last months He is really revealing the deception that is going on with those tv preachers. Some have likeable personalities, lots of charisma – but don't be fooled. They are even using sorcery to draw people to their teachings. I'm sorry I ever said yahweh or jehovah or hallelujah, but all I can do is show you what He reveals to me and as we learn together, we have to come up out of this deception and filth.

We will go deeper into this teaching and even look at the origin of hallelujah and see who that is praising.
