NOT a MANDELA EFFECT – Part 1: FALSE GODS GAD, MENI

We are going to take this teaching slow and not get in a hurry because in the process of putting this message together God revealed some false gods that are not made obvious in our KJV Bibles and I'm going to bring that out so we can understand who is being referenced.

In 2018 I was part of a supposed group of Christians that were sharing and discussing Mandela Effects in the Bible, mainly the KJV. I have since left that group as they are not really after the truth but have another agenda. I do not bear witness with them nor do I see any fruit of Christianity, at least in the administrators and the outspoken ones of this group. I used to be in some so called Christian groups on facebook talking about the end times. I have come to learn that most groups on facebook are nothing more than groups that have alterior motives. Groups that are all about fighting and twisting Scripture and coming against truth. This really is to keep the body of Christ in turmoil. Most of these groups are filled with trolls and shills. If you are in a group that is fighting against God's Word and there is no peace in the group, you should leave that group.

There were bullies in the group and for the most part it seemed they just tried to find stuff and say it was a Mandela Effect even if it wasn't. Then, as long as the majority said it had changed or was new, then that was that – end of discussion. People in that group were just making up Mandela Effects and because there were enough trolls and shills to go along and back the outlandish suggestions, then that was the general consensus of the group. It was such non-sense. This is not the way to handle the changes we are seeing in the KJV. First of all with people online you have no idea of their Christian walk. You don't even know if they have a Bible much less if they read it or have ever read it. You don't know if they love Jesus and are truly seeking Him with a sincere heart. You don't know who is behind those profile pictures and screen names. Those that serve satan have no problem saying they read God's Word and know it by heart and when you look a little deeper you find they don't even know God or His Word. But the one screaming the loudest is the one that the group follows. Utter nonsense.

To recognize KJV Biblical Mandela Effects you have to have Holy Spirit discernment, have read the KJV of God's Word and know Him intimately. Preferably have read the KJV through many times over and are familiar with the language of it as well with having had memorized Scriptures from it. Those running disinfo campains against the Mandela Effect try to say that the Mandela Effect is just poor memory or people remembering wrong. That's a lie to draw many away from the truth. Most have never read and studied from the KJV much less fom any version of God's Word to recognize any differences at all. Once you understand what the Mandela Effect is and its purpose you can study deeper and vet out the changes, and note them in your Bibles as best you can. I did a message on the Mandela Effect a few years ago. Youtube pulled Part One and so it can only be found on our church website. The message was titled "Mandela Effect – Part One." There is a reason they pulled that message, because it contains so much truth and exposure of what is going on with their dark magic paired with science coming against the translations we have of God's Word, especially the KJV.

At the time I left, the group had 257 members. Most of the time less than 10 were always posting and commenting. You could easily see who was running the group. The first time I ever commented on some of the changes and did not agree with them, they quickly began to argue with me. I said surely you can understand by the leading of the Holy Spirit. The reply was something along the lines of that just leads to emotions and feelings getting into the way and pride and ones ego rising up. Basically saying that when you rely on the Holy Spirit you are selectively choosing what is right and what is wrong. WOW!! That is a subtle way of slamming the Holy Spirit and saying blatantly that we must not trust Him. I was floored, the Holy Spirit is God afterall. That statement alone clued me in to this person's lack of knowledge of God and that their relationship was off.

Here is what the Bible teaches us:

1 Cor. 2:14 - But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

You are not even going to understand God's Word much less see any tampering if you don't even have Holy Spirit discernment.

This describes what was going on in that group, walking after the flesh and not after the Spirit. We are in dark times and it is only getting darker. There are those out there who want to sneak in and subtly deceive you and have you not even trust in God. We are in times where truth is being censored and held back by those in power that serve lucifer. We had better get familiar with the Holy Spirit and trust and depend on Him. He's our Teacher and Comforter and without being baptised into Him, you have a powerless Christian walk. You will be decieved and led astray without the teaching and guidance of the Holy Spirit.

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Was this always like this? Doesn't it sound like Islam, so much slaughtering going on in the KJV.

Isaiah 65:12 – Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before Mine eyes, and did choose that wherein I delighted not.

#2 Another new "bow down" and this time "to the slaughter".

#3 Horrid

To understand what this verse means and to really know God's character, you need to read the Old Testament too, not just the New Testament.

God is the same and He does not change.

Heb. 13:8 - Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. (Jesus Christ yesterday and today (is) the same, even to the ages).

Let's read the passage of Scripture she mentioned above in context so we can understand what is being said here. "Bow down" is not new here and it is not a Mandela Effect.

Isaiah 65:1-12 – 1. I Am sought of them that asked not for Me; I Am found of them that sought Me not: I said, Behold Me, behold Me, unto a nation that was not called by My name (Interlinear Bible: unto a nation not calling on My name). **2.** I have spread out My hands all the day unto a rebellious people, which (who) walketh in a way that was not good, after their own thoughts; **3.** A people that (who) provoketh Me to anger continually to My face (Int. B. – A people who provoke Me to My face continually); that sacrifice in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick; **4.** Which remain among the graves (Who sit among the graves), and lodge in the monuments (and they sleep in watch towers), which (who) eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels (and broth of unclean things in their pots); **5.** Which (Who) say, Stand by thyself (Draw near to yourself), come not near to me; for I am holier than thou. These are a smoke in My nose, a fire that burneth all the day. **6.** Behold, it is written before Me: I will not keep silence, but will recompense (repay), even recompense into their bosom, **7.** Your iniquities, and the iniquities of your fathers together, saith the LORD, which have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed Me upon the hills: therefore will I measure their former work into their bosom. **8.** Thus saith the LORD, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one saith, destroy it not; for a blessing is in it: so will I do for My servants' sakes, that I may not destroy them all (in order not to destroy the whole). **9.** And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of My mountains (and out of Judah one to inherit My mountain): and Mine elect (chosen) shall inherit it, and My servants shall dwell there. **10.** And Sharon shall be (become) a fold of flocks, and the valley of Achor a place (resting place) for the herds to lie down in, for My people that (who) have sought Me.

11. But ye are they that forsake the LORD, that forget My holy mountain, that prepare a table for that troop, and that furnish the drink offering unto that number.

INTERLINEAR BIBLE

v. 11 – But you (are) those who forsake the LORD, who forget My holy mountain, who set in order for **Fortune** a table, and who fill for **Fate** mixed wine.

Fortune is capitalized and so is Fate and yet they are contained within the sentence. After digging into this I discovered that these are false gods.

NIV

Isaiah 65:11 - "But as for you who forsake the LORD and forget My holy mountain, who spread a table for **Fortune** and fill bowls of mixed wine for **Destiny**,

YOUNG'S LITERAL TRANSLATION

Who are setting in array for **Gad** a table, And who are filling for **Meni** a mixture.

This is speaking of their idolatry in worshipping other gods. They were setting a table, that is an altar with offerings to this false god, Gad also called Fortune. And

they were pouring out drink offerings to another false god called Meni or Destiny or Fate.

We see where God did mention them pouring out drink offerings to the queen of heaven in Jeremiah.

Jeremiah 44:19 - And when we burned incense to the queen of heaven, and poured out drink offerings unto her, did we make her cakes to worship her, and pour out drink offerings unto her, without our men (Int. B.: to make an image and pour out to her drink offerings)?

This is the same false god Meni, Destiny or Fate spoken of in Isaiah 65:11. Those women threw their men under the bus with them!

The Geneva Bible has a note: By the multitude and number, He means their innumerable idols, of whom they thought they could never have enough.

We can see that for whatever reason they missed it or did not bring this out correctly. You must pray and research and vet out the truth. Even the Geneva Bible is not pure because they state that Jesus Christ is Michael and we know that isn't true. It is important to note that God dealt mostly with a few false God's in Scripture. Most of the Old Testament He was dealing with baal and ashtareth or asherah. That is exactly who these two gods equate to as well.

I want you to notice that in this passage the KJV has made it hard to understand that God is talking about the false gods they were serving by name. KJV only readers are missing this because it has been glossed over and made hard to see. I thank God for the Mandela Effect because it has caused me to go deeper in digging some of these things out. Gad was the name of the pan-Semitic **god** of **fortune**, and is attested in ancient records of Aram and Arabia. Gad is also mentioned by the Book of Isaiah (Isaiah 65:11 - some translations simply call him (the **god** of) **Fortune**), as having been worshipped by a number of Hebrews during the **babylonian** captivity.

Names in Biblical times always had meaning and so they do today as well. In Genesis chapters 29 & 30, when Jacob's wives and concubines began to have children, we see that many meanings of their names are given.

Genesis 30:11 - And Leah said, A troop cometh: and she called his name Gad.

Leah was from Mesopotamia and had been raised in a house that did not know God. So this is a pagan name.

Interlinear says: And Leah said with fortune and she called his name Gad. **Other translations** say that she said What good fortune or How fortunate! So we see that this traces to a false god or idol called Gad and he was the god of Fortune and was also called Fortune.

Gad is also mentioned by the Book of Isaiah (Isaiah 65:11 - some translations simply call him (the **god** of) Fortune), as having been worshipped by a number of Hebrews during the babylonian captivity. Gad apparently differed from the **god of destiny**, who was known as **Meni**.


Gad (deity) - Wikipedia https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Gad_(deity)

Goddess name "Gad"	Western Semitic / Punic / Carthaginian	God of uncertain status. Probably concerned with chance or fortune and known from Palmyrene inscriptions, and from the Vetus Testamentum in place names such as Baal-Gad and Midal-Gad. Popular across a wide area of Syrio-Palestine and Anatolia in preBiblical times. Thought to have been syncretized ultimately with the Greek goddess TYCHE
Goddess name "Fortuna"	Roman	The goddess of chance or good luck, was worshipped both in Greece and Italy, and more particularly at Rome, where she was considered as the steady goddess of good luck, success, and every kind of prosperity. Roman
Goddess name "Fortuna"	Roman	Goddess of good fortune. A deity who particularly appealed to women, partly in an oracular context. She is depicted carrying a globe, rudder and cornucoplae. She probably evolved from the model of the Greek goddess TYCHE. Her main symbol is the wheel of fate which she may stand upon and Renaissance artists tended to depict her thus. Among her more celebrated sanctuaries in Rome, the temple of Fortuna Redux was built by Domitian to celebrate his victories in Germany. She is depicted in a well-known stone carving in Gloucester Museum, England, holding her three main attributes

Knobel identifies Gad with the sun, Meni with the moon, men, mene in Greek; *the queen of heaven* (Jer 7:18; Jer 44:17-18).



This would be Gad or as usually referred to in the Bible – baal also known as Nimrod and ultimately satan. His Mesopotamian name is Utu and later it became Shamash.



And here is Inanna, Ishtar, Isis, Ashtareth, "Queen of Heaven", Goddess of the moon and the Mother of ALL harlots (Rev. 17 & 18). The horns were supposed to represent strength and power. The wings were to indicate deity. She is pictured with one of her familiar animals the owl. She used then in her dark magic witchcraft. She could invoke her spirit into the animal and vice versa. Another one of her familiars is the bunny rabbit we see in "Easter" because Easter is not an event but rather her name. People are kidding themselves saying they are celebrating Jesus Christ with rabbits and eggs.



Roman gods L: Jupiter/Zeus R: Fortuna/Queen of Heaven. Remember Nimrod and Ashtoreth became known by thousands of names. Where you see one of them you always find the other. Usually there is a male god that stands for something and there is his wife/consort/mate that stands for the same thing. Some research says that Gad was for Jupiter (the greater) and Meni was for Venus (the lesser) – gods of fortune.

and who fill mixed wine for Fate, Destiny or Meni)

Mammetum: Babylonian, goddess of the maker or mother of fate.

<u>Marduk:</u> Babylonian, god of magic. Main god of the pantheon, although he isn't the chief. Killed Tiamat and used her body to create the earth and sky out of respect for her battle prowess.

Mummu: Babylonian, god of craftsmen.

Mushdamma: Sumerian, god of houses and foundations

Nabu: Babylonian, god of writing and wisdom.

Nammu: Sumerian, goddess of the Watery Abyss, the Primeval Sea, the Primordial Mother.

Nammu: Babylonian, goddess of "the pure goddess", associated with fresh water. Nammu was the Primordial Mother Goddess, creator of the gods, in the Sumerian myths. She got demoted by the time the Babylonians got to her.

Namtar: Sumerian, demon of fate, responsible for death.

Goddess name "Fata-Morgana"	Celtic	Goddess of the sea, illusion, enchantment, fate and death and queen of the Fortunate Isles. Celtic
Goddess name "Fate"	Roman	A goddess of fate
God name "Fates"	Greek	Properly signifies "a share," and as a personification "the deity who åśśigns to every man his fate or his share," or the Fates. Homer usually speaks of only one Moira, and only once mentions the Motpai in the plural. In his poems Moira is fate personified, which, at the birth of man, spins out the thread of his future life, follows his steps, and directs the consequences of his actions according to the counsel of the gods. Homer thus, when he personifies Fate, conceives her as spinning, an act by which also the power of other gods over the life of man is expressed. Greek
Goddess name "Fatima"	Syrian	The great goddess of the moon and fate, the source of the Sun and the virgin queen of heaven . Syrian
"Fatit"	Albania	Female entities who are in charge of the individuals destiny. Albania



I could not help but think of Minnie Mouse. Walt Disney was a freemason and that is exactly what they do, they name things after false gods just like our vocabulary has been set up on. When you type "meni" in the google search engine the word menu comes up. Interesting. This false god name "Meni" reminds me of the word many. Sounds the same doesn't it. Looking this up on wiktionary the Turkish etymology is "many" from Arabic. Synonyms for "meni" are bel – no surprise there. Dikel, interesting that if you leave the "l" off you have dike. Other synonyms, er suyu, sperm and sperma. That sounds like a male and female false god and as usual they have sex twisted up in the perversion.



Wheel of Fortune, a tv show that has been on the air for almost 45 years.



Where do you think they got the name and idea for that show? I always say it is all spiritual but we have not known the occultic or new age side of things. The

church has gone silent in exposing it and now witches are teaching from the pulpits and they certainly are not going to expose this stuff. The wheel of fortune represents luck – the goddess of fate is responsible for its rise and fall in the course of life. The blindfold symbolizes the randomness of events. Those that worshipped her knew that it all depended on her mood as to what their fate would be. L: The wheel of Fate is running over that lady. R: The goddess Fate is blind folded as if man's fate is just a random spin of her wheel. She has the king and his jesters or servants on the wheel to spin and see what their fate would be.



"Lady Luck"



We can't forget the Irish who have brought us the Druids and so much with the witchcraft runes. A 4 leaf clover and a lady bug both said to be "lucky".

CLOSING

So we see that in the passage from Isaiah 65, God was angered at the Israelites who stayed always in idolatry, prostituting themselves out to false gods/fallen angels/nephilim/titans/demons and idols.

With the name Gad or Fortune you will also find that people often equated their fortune or luck to many different gods.

Are you doing that? Do you find yourself crossing your fingers hoping something goes your way? How we casually say "good luck" to someone? Or saying things like I was lucky etc? Are you reading horoscopes every day before you go anywhere? Are you depending on them to determine how your day will be or what your personality is like? Are you having your fortune told or going to palm readers or tarot card readers? All of this is witchcraft and is against a Holy God. If you have done these things you need to confess and repent and close the doors to satan and his demons that you have opened in your life.

The God of the Bible has planned your life and when you submit to Him and obey Him, He orders your steps. There is no chance or fate or luck involved. **Psalm 37:23** - The steps of a *good* man are ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in his way.

This is a Mandela Effect – it used to say: The steps of a righteous man are ordered by the LORD...

In Jeremiah 29:11 God told the Israelites He had good plans for them. To give them a future and a hope. Plans for peace and not of evil. If He had plans for them that were good, don't you think He has plans for your life in Christ even more so?

When you submit fully to God, He is in control of your life, there is no chance, or fate, or luck or happen stance.
