The land lord decided to ask a ridiculous amount of money for the land. He also wanted us to buy more land that we could even afford as a package deal. He wanted an unreasonable amount as a down payment. I could tell he was just trying to prophet off of the church. He wanted thousands more than the land was worth. We don't have that kind of money now and we didn't have it then either. So when we did not agree to his terms he evicted the church. So we had to tear down this church building and in the meanwhile Pastor Erustus had to search for a good piece of land to build the church again. This is the city where he lives and where the headquarter church was to be for all five of the churches and schools he has planted so far.

I want you to understand that at this time other churches and pastors were going to the landlord and trying to turn him against Pastor Erustus. Trying to make him

evict him and trying to defeat him. So many there are jealous of Pastor and the church that God has blessed him with. They can't understand why his church has grown so fast to be so new there. But yet they are living compromised lives before the Lord and cannot understand why He is not blessing their churches.


