
THE BAPTISM of the HOLY SPIRIT – Part 3 – DIFFERENT EVIDENCES, FALSE TONGUES

Youtuber Candy Cruncher shared: I and a friend who has passed both spoke in tongues and were led to Jesus by men who wanted to speak in tongues but never did. Yet they we're true believers and filled with Holy Spirit!



Youtuber: Ann Miller asked: Does one always know the exact time and moment they are baptized into the Holy Spirit? Or does it happen over time, or both?

The baptism of the Holy Spirit does not happen over time. It is instant and immediate. Now the fresh infillings or refilling and anointings happen continuously over the period of a Christians lifetime as they stay hungry for God and pray for more of Him and ask for fresh infillings of His Spirit.

For those who have had true ministers of God lay hands on them and pray for them to be baptized into the Holy Spirit, if they were truly saved first and had sincere hearts, then they were baptized right then and there. It is received by faith. For some of us, like myself, I realized something was happening but did not know what it was until later. It was later on that I realized and learned that I had been baptized into the Holy Spirit. For those that prayed like Pastor Dalbeer did to receive the baptism, and they belonged to Christ and sincerely wanted that baptism, then they received it by faith right then when they prayed. Even if you think you have received the baptism of the Holy Spirit already, I would still pray

the prayer and ask just to cover my bases and be sure. I will have a prayer for everyone who wants to receive this baptism to pray at the close of part four.

The Holy Spirit is the power of God and He is truly amazing. You will not make it in your Christian walk without Him.

In the early church the most common sign of the Holy Spirit baptism was the sign of speaking in an unknown tongue (language). You see that through the book of Acts. (Acts 2:4, Acts 10:44-48, 19:6)

But remember speaking in tongues is not the only sign there is. There are other signs.

DIFFERENT EVIDENCES AND EXAMPLES OF BEING FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

Luke 1:41-45 - And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth (Elizabeth) heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth (Elizabeth) was filled with the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit): And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed *art* thou among women, and blessed *is* the fruit of thy womb. And whence *is* this to me (Why am I so favored), that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy. And blessed *is* she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord (You are blessed because you believed that the Lord would do what he said.").

Elizabeth did not speak in tongues but instead she prophesied.

Acts 4:31 - And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit), and they spake the word of God with boldness.

They did not speak in tongues but they spoke the Word of God with boldness.

Acts 5:15-16 - Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid *them* on beds and couches (mats), that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them. There came also a multitude *out* of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks (their sick), and them

which were vexed with unclean spirits (tormented by evil or unclean spirits): and they were healed every one.

These People were laid in the streets and being healed just from Peter's shadow being cast on them. That is the power of the Holy Spirit. That is an evidence of being filled.

Ephesians 5:18-21 – And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess (because that will ruin your life); but be filled with the Spirit; Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God (out of reverence for Christ).

These are more signs of being filled. Do you ever go around your house singing to the Lord? Do you ever sing to him while driving down the road? Not just in church where everyone is singing, but even when you are alone or with your family?

Do you thank God in prayer and throughout the day? We don't thank Him for trouble or trials in our lives but we thank Him for being with us in the storm and that He will bring us out the other side of it.

In submitting yourselves to your brothers and sisters in Christ, do you lay your life down for them? Do you stop what you are doing to say a prayer for their situation? Do you help them carry their burdens? Do you encourage them in the Scriptures? Do you submit yourself to your pastor and the spiritual leaders or spiritual parents in your life?

Acts 6:3 – Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit) and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

Wisdom is one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 13:52 – And the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Spirit.

Joy is one of the fruits of the Spirit.

Acts 8:14-17 – Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God (accepted the Word of God), they sent unto them Peter and John: Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit): (For as yet He (the Holy Spirit) was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) Then laid they *their* hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit).

No mention here that they spoke in tongues.

Acts 9:17-19 - And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit). And immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized. And when he had received meat (food), he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus.

Here was Apostle Paul being baptized into the Holy Spirit and yet we see no mention of him speaking in tongues at this point. We know that at least later on he did speak in tongues by what is recorded in 1 Corinthians chapter 14.

John 3:8 - The wind bloweth where it listeth (wherever it wants), and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit (so it is with everyone that is born of the Spirit / you cannot explain how people are born of the Spirit).

1 Cor.12:28-30, 1 Cor.13:1 - And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues (those who speak in unknown languages). Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles? Have all the gifts of healing? do all speak with tongues? do all interpret? But covet earnestly the best gifts (earnestly desire the most helpful gifts): and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way. Though I speak with the tongues of men

and of angels, and have not charity (love), I am become *as* sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.

Paul made a point, not everyone will have each gift. But we will all have at least one gift from the Holy Spirit. But he goes further to show that no matter what your gift or gifts from the Holy Spirit are, even if you speak in tongues, if you don't have love then it is useless and of no effect.

Do you know there are mean spirited people claiming to be filled with the Holy Spirit? When you run up on a mean person saying they are a Christian then you must look for fruit. Everyone can have a bad day or mess up so don't judge them on just one occasion. But when someone is continually mean and nasty then something is wrong. They probably are not filled with the Holy Spirit.

Matt.7:15-20 - Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. Ye shall know them by their fruits (by the way they act). Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither *can* a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

1 Cor.12:7-11 — But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal (for the common good / to help each other). For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom (the ability to give wise advise); to another the word of knowledge (message of special knowledge) by the same Spirit; To another faith (great faith) by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits (distinguishing between spirits / the ability to discern whether a message is from the Spirit of God or from another spirit); to another divers kinds of tongues (the ability to speak in unknown languages); to another the interpretation of tongues (the ability to interpret what is being said): But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will.

When you see these gifts in operation it is a good sign that the person is filled with the Holy Spirit. Because each one of these gifts is a manifestation of the Holy Spirit. But you still have to test the spirits to see if they are of God.

1 John 4:1 – Beloved, believe not every spirit (do not believe everyone who claims to speak by the Spirit), but try (test) the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Even when you see those gifts in operation, test them because if many false prophets were in the world 2000 years ago, can you imagine how many there are now? satan and his crew have only perfected their lying wonders and signs and trickery which is all just witch craft plain and simple.

The tv is filled with these false prophets. I have heard them teach their false teachings about the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. I have heard some of them speak in tongues. Because I know they practice witchcraft then I know those tongues are not of God.

Please play from 13:19 to 17:25 This video was made 13 years ago exposing satanism in the church. Kenneth Copeland and Rodney Brown make up things in tongues. Rodney Brown lays hands on many and transfers a false anointing, a kundalini anointing to them. He even tells them not to pray and that is so that his satanic anointing can take hold on them.(about 4 min's)

These are not Godly tongues. These are not men of God but rather satan's ministers.

People are so hungry for supernatural power that they want to take a short cut and not read God's Word, not pray and develop a true relationship with Him. They don't want to wait on Him. Instead they just want to go down front and have false ministers lay hands on them and transfer whatever spirits are on them. Many people are just looking for a feeling or an experience and satan will come through for that person every time. God doesn't work that way.

Don't worry and focus on whether you speak in tongues or not. The main thing is to be humble and sincere in being repentant and seeking the Lord and seek the baptism of the Holy Spirit and let The Spirit move and do what He wants to. He is God, He is the Spirit of God, the power of God. He knows how to equip you for a powerful life in Christ and He knows what gifts to give you so that you can be effective within the Body of Christ and to further God's Kingdom. The gifts are to strengthen, edify and build up the Body of Christ. Get intimate with the Holy Spirit and let Him know He is welcome in your life. Talk with the Holy Spirit in your prayer time and worship Him.

The fire of the Holy Spirit purges sin (a process called *sanctification*) and ignites a flame of passion (love for Jesus) in our hearts.


Those of you who have been filled with the Holy Spirit in the past but have let the oil run out of your spiritual lamps, I encourage you to go to the Lord and ask for a fresh infilling of the Spirit. We should do this often. Ask Jesus to give you a fresh infilling, to fill you up to the top and overflowing. Ask the Lord to help you to be effective for His Kingdom.

Used to be standard procedure to get saved, then get water baptized and then for the minister to lay hands on and pray for the person to be baptized into the Holy Spirit. Now the church doesn't teach this or do this.

Deliverance right after salvation is not happening either. Once you are saved you still have all of the demonic attachments and generational curses that you walked in with. After you are saved, you have to now use the power and authority and the blood of Jesus Christ to break all of these things off of your life. I did a teaching on breaking generational curses off called "Spiritual Warfare in your House," it is in my sermon notes on our church website and in the info. box on youtube.

Many people have not been able to stop sinning or stop bad habits because they are not filled with the Holy Spirit. He is the power that helps you to overcome the flesh.

Smith Wigglesworth, whether he ultimately was a false teacher or not, this information that I am sharing today I felt was accurate.

We must not forget that the Giver is to be received before the gifts. Salvation always precedes sanctification, and sanctification will always precede the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Sanctification prepares the body for the Holy Spirit, and when the body is rightly prepared for the Spirit, then it is the work of Jesus to baptize with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit then makes Jesus King in your life; you regard Him as Lord and Master over all things, and you become submissive to Him in all things. You are not afraid to say, "You are mine!" I love You!" I love Him. He is so beautiful; He is so sweet; He is so loving; He is so kind! He never turns a deaf ear; He never leaves you in distress. He heals broken heartedness; He liberates the captive; and for those who are down and out, He comes right into that place and lifts the burden. It is truly said of Him, "He came to His own and His own had no room for Him; but to as many as had room for Him, He gave them power to become the sons of God." (see John 1:11-12)

The baptism is the last thing; if you do not get this, you are living in a weak and impoverished condition that is no good to yourself or anybody else. You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you (Acts 1:8). If you have no

power, you have not repented. You say, "That's hard language." It is truth. – Smith Wigglesworth
