

Q & A: WARD OFF EVIL SPIRITS, SPIRITUAL WARFARE, POSTING SCRIPTURE on WINDOWS

Terri wrote in: I was listening to another ministry on warfare and cleansing your home. They did it much like yourself, however, they posted a page from the Bible (Psalm 91) on their windows facing the outside of their home.

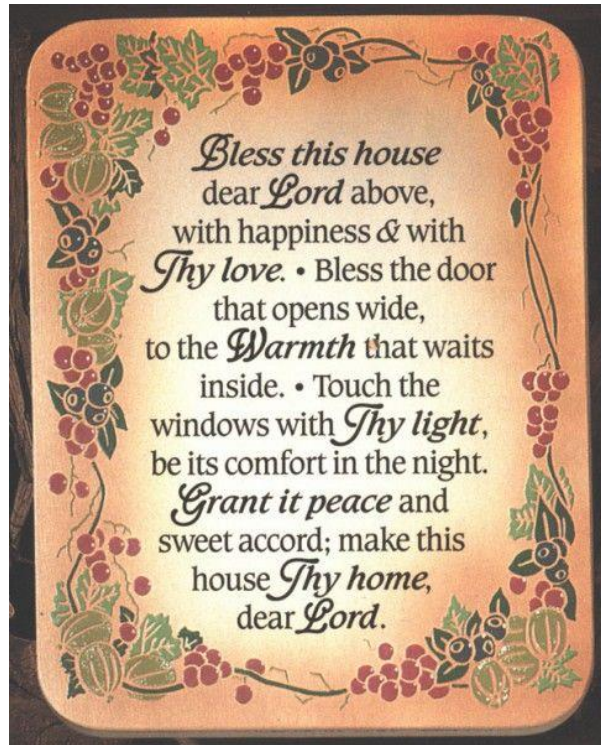
QUESTION: Is this witchcraft? I would like to know your thoughts on this – I should take it to the Lord in prayer. Thank you for all that you do!

ANSWER: It is not witchcraft because it is not casting a spell of any kind, it is God's Word. However, it is superstition.

When Kennedy was really young, maybe 5 or 6 years old, she had some demonic attacks. The demons like to frighten little children because they feed off of their fear. This was right about the time I was receiving my call to the ministry. The spirit realm was all stirred up and satan will attack you through your children. He wants to get at you any way he can.

I had taught Kennedy how to fight spiritually already at such a young age. satan really doesn't like a spiritually equipped child of God. But she was still scared with a natural fear. So of course we prayed and kept her covered in the blood of Jesus and anointed her room and did the spiritual warfare that parents should do over their children. But to give her some comfort we wrote a Scripture that she had learned in school, Isaiah 41:10, she wrote the first part of it on paper, Fear not for I am with thee. She colored it and then she taped it up around her room. She even put a couple in mine and Scott's room. This had no spiritual impact but it brought Kennedy comfort.

Let's think about taking a page from the Bible and taping it to our window so that something on the outside could read it.



Bless this house dear Lord above, with happiness & with Thy love. Bless the door that opens wide, to the warmth that waits inside. Touch the windows with Thy light, be its comfort in the night. Grant it peace and sweet accord; make this house Thy home, dear Lord.

I'm sure you have all seen these type of decorative house blessing wall plaques. Does hanging this up inside of your home cause it to be blessed by God? No it doesn't. Being truly saved and living a righteous and obedient life is what causes your home to be blessed by God.



This is wall art with part of Psalm 91 written on it. Psalm 91 speaks of God protecting us and our homes. Do you think hanging something like this up in your home or putting it on paper and placing it on the windows so a demonic spirit can read it from the outside will protect you? No it won't.

Our protection comes from God alone. When we have been truly saved through Jesus Christ and are living in obedience to Him, thereby showing Him we love Him, then He automatically commands His angels to protect us and intervene when they need to. He protects us from the attacks of the enemy. And all that we have. Those that don't live obedient lives do not have His full blessing or protection on their lives.

Some of the basic things that mark a real Christians life are: being committed in seeking God in prayer & fasting, studying the Word, fellowship of the saints, praising and worshipping God, giving, ministering or serving in the church/ God's Kingdom, living holy, etc. These keep satan and his demons off our life.

Developing a strong relationship with God is very significant. This is how you keep

the full armor of God on at all times too. And we should all be pleading the blood of Jesus over ourselves and our families and our homes daily.

John 14:15 - If ye love Me, (you will) keep My commandments.

Romans 8:28 - And we know that (God causes) all things (to) work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose (for them).

Is God causing all things to work together for the good of everyone? Or of everyone that says they are a Christian? No, He isn't. He is only doing that for those that love Him. Remember, we just read that Jesus said in order for us to show Him we love Him, we will obey Him. So if you are not obeying Him, then don't expect anything from Him.

And of course anointing your home also only works if you are a true servant of Jesus Christ. Remember, God does not bless sin.

And also, someone who says, but I'm a good person, that means nothing to God. If you don't have the blood of His Son applied to your life through salvation, then you don't even belong to Him and your life is an open prey for satan and his minions to wreak havoc on you and all that pertains to you.

If an evil spirit approached a home that had Scripture posted on the windows, it isn't going to stop and read them. It is the same concept as thinking just because there is a Bible in the house that, that house is protected. There are many houses that have Bibles in them collecting dust. In the spirit realm, it is clear to see which homes have God's protection on them and which ones don't. It is based on what altar is being served in that home. Is it God's altar or satan's altar? There can only be one.
