Did you know corn was never in the Bible at all. Not in one verse anywhere ever. Now it is all over the KJ Bible. It was not even a crop in Biblical times.

The other translations make it clear that the word grain should have been there and not corn. If you rub a corn cob you are not going to get any kernels of corn to come off, much less eat raw corn like that. What utter non-sense.

**John 12:24** - Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

This passage is speaking about what Jesus was about to do, He was the grain of wheat that died so that He could bring forth much fruit, that's us.

Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

Look at the KJ. A corn of wheat. What on earth? Just crazy. It is a grain or kernel of wheat. And just remember in the OT, when Joseph was second in command in Egypt he never stored up vats of corn, it was grain or wheat that saved Egypt and all the nations.

This next passage is when Gabriel told Mary that she was going to be impregnated with Jesus.

**Luke 1:35** – And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

That “holy thing?” What mockery.

For this thing I besought the Lord thrice (three times I begged the Lord ), that it might depart from me. And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness (My power works best in weakness). Most gladly therefore will I rather glory (boast) in my infirmities (weaknesses), that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities (weaknesses), in reproaches (insults), in necessities (hardships), in persecutions, in distresses (troubles) for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

I want you to notice he ends by saying: when I am weak, then am I strong.

That's why I take pleasure in my weaknesses, and in the insults, hardships, persecutions, and troubles that I suffer for Christ. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

For the sake of Christ, then, I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

That is why, for the sake of Christ, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

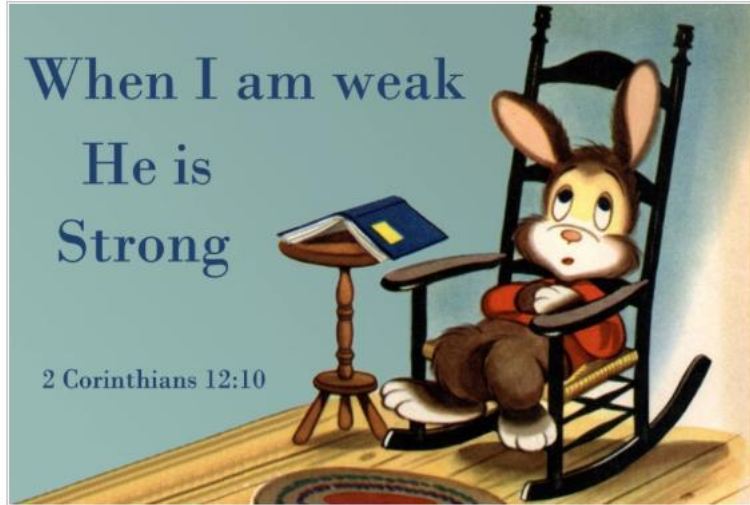
They all say when I am weak, then I am strong. This Mandela Effect is across all translations. Let's look at the remaining evidence of what is used to say. I found so much on this one.

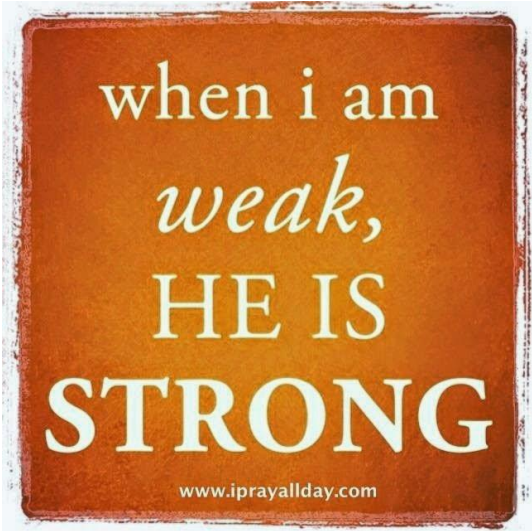

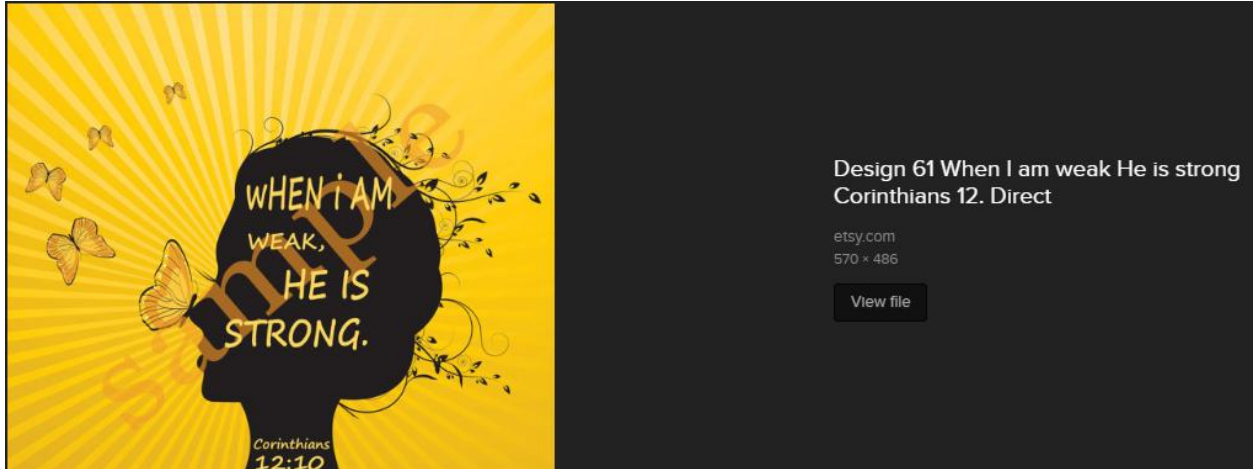

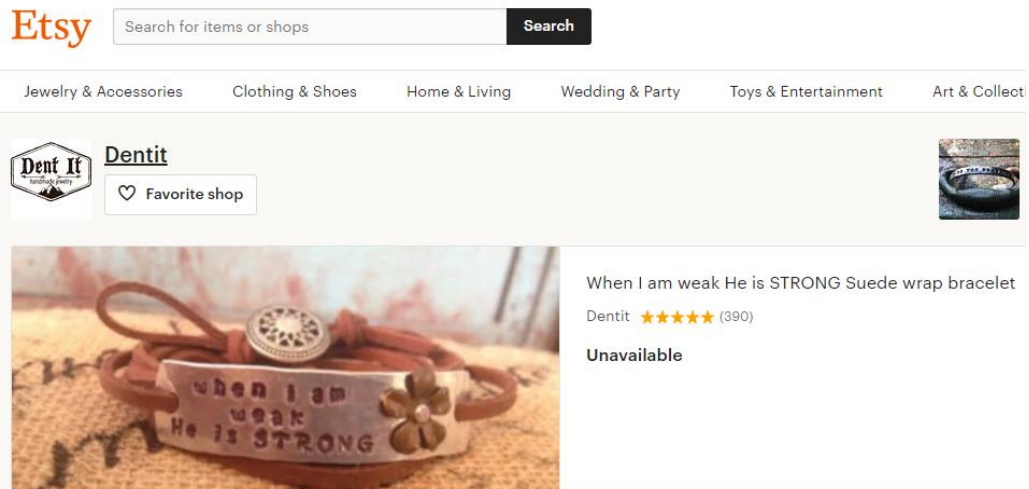
