JESUITS and the PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE – Pt 5: ANTICHRIST PAPACY STIGMA, JEWISH ANTICHRIST, MACDONALD

"Though Darby was not among those attending the [earlier] Albury meetings, he later claimed as his own many of the conclusions reached at Albury Park. Certainly, by the time the Albury meetings were concluded, Irving had well perfected the new *Ben-Ezra* ideas when he took it to the 1833 Powerscourt conference – the loose ends were tied together … We should mention that Darby answered the question, 'Is there a prospect of a revival of Apostolic churches before the coming of Christ?' … Powerscourt saw the teaching of a pretribulation rapture introduced. It developed into its full bloom at these meetings … Though others *e.g.* Irving offered a secret rapture idea, its origin has since been attributed to Darby by most scholars."^[35]

It is at the Albury Conferences in 1830, shortly before the Powerscourt Conferences, where speaking in tongues is first recorded as taking place, which forms another aspect of Dispensationalist theology.

"Irving, was also the first to have tongues in his congregation ... Irving permitted the "miraculous gifts" at his Presbyterian Church, causing the elders to excommunicate him and lock him out. He then formed his Catholic Apostolic Church down the street in 1831."^[36]

Darby strenuously resisted speaking in tongues, and regarded them as "devilish":

"Though Darby was not among those attending the (earlier) Albury meetings, he later claimed as his own many of the conclusions reached at Albury Park. Certainly, by the time the Albury meetings were concluded, Irving had well perfected the new Ben-Ezra / Lacunza ideas when he took it to the 1833 Powerscourt conference – the loose ends were tied together...We should mention that Darby answered the question, 'Is there a prospect of a revival of Apostolic churches before the coming of Christ?'...Powerscourt saw the teaching of a pretribulation rapture introduced. It developed into its full bloom at these meetings...Though others e.g. Irving offered a secret rapture idea, its origin has since been attributed to Darby by most scholars."

I don't attribute it to him. I attribute it to Paul who wrote about it under inspiration of the Holy Spirit. And remember the Roman Catholic Church had squashed all teachings and they had died off with those that taught them. Then they held the monopoly on God's Word until it finally began to get out to the people. It has taken a while it seems for real teachers and ministers of God to begin to see the pre-trib rapture for themselves and speak out on it. The witches cannot remain silent forever because God's true servants will expose them and the truth will get out. So one of their tactics is just to go ahead and embrace the truth but pervert it and smut it up in some way.

The consensus is that if the tongues were from the devil then everything taught by Irving was from the devil including the pre-trib rapture. Notice that because Irving allowed the gifts of the Holy Spirit to operate in his church, they kicked him out.

2 Tim.3:5 - Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

There are many that profess to be Christians but want no part of the Holy Spirit. They are not Christian at all and have no power from God moving in and through their lives. There are many churches that fake the gifts of the Holy Spirit, that put on shows and even those that try to teach the gifts into a person. All of that is out of order. But I assure you the Holy Spirit is real, and every single gift mentioned in Scripture is still available to us today. He is the One Who decides what gift to give to whom.

Back to Irving and Darby: they cannot even agree among themselves on their mixing of truth with lies. Speaking in tongues is clearly in Scripture and I have already taught on that one. And we don't know if they were speaking Godly

tongues or not because there are satanic tongues as well. We weren't there to judge these things. There is a gift of speaking in tongues by the Holy Spirit.

Lacunza's *The Coming of the Messiah in Majesty and Glory* is also particularly valuable as it presents two Jesuit views which contributed to the counter-Reformation, with Ribera's view (which is futurism meaning the book of Revelation is in the future still) being generally accepted by most Protestant churches today – the only Protestant church which still officially adheres to the Historicist mode of prophetic interpretation is the Seventh Day Adventist church. I included this to give you an idea of how they float different teachings out. Then some churches stand on this and some on that and they just continue to get new teachings and stances and on and on it goes.

Although this view – that the Antichrist was an individual who would be a Jew – was first formed by fellow Jesuit Francisco Ribera in the latter part of the sixteenth century, this was a far from *universal* view on the identity of the Antichrist, as until this time it had been completely rejected by Protestants.

Just to note, Francisco Ribera is not Alberto Rivera who was another Jesuit from our time. So before the 19th century, protestants were not looking for a 1-man Jewish anti-christ. I have heard that teaching floated out there by all the telewitches / false teachers on tv. That the antichrist is going to be a Jew because the Jews will not accept anyone that isn't a Jew. MARGARET MACDONALD'S VISION

Many people say that this young woman had a vision about the rapture and that is where the whole teaching came from.

According to Wikipedia, around 1826 to 1829 there were preachers in Scotland where Margaret lived that said the world's problems could only be addressed through an outbreak of supernatural gifts from the Holy Spirit. Supposedly around this time healings began to happen and some of the people at these meetings began to speak in tongues. Some believed the tongues were real and some believed they were demonic. Edward Irving believed the displays happening there were real and John Nelson Darby believed they were demonic.

There have been a couple of attempts to locate a "source" for Darby's concept of the rapture – the belief that a core of Christian believers who have died will be raised from the dead, and believers who are still alive and remain shall be "caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air" (1 Thess 4:17) in conjunction with the Second Coming of Jesus Christ. Some of these attempts imply that Darby's concepts originated from a "false" source. Samuel Prideaux Tregelles alleged that The concept was taken from one of the charismatic utterances in Edward Irving's church. Since Tregelles regarded the utterances as "pretending to be from God," his implication is that Darby's rapture is from a demonic source. To make a correction to what they believe the rapture is, it is not called the second coming in Scripture. However, it will be the next coming of Christ where He only comes in the air, in the clouds, and does not step foot on this earth but receives His saints up to Himself in the sky. The dead in Christ, including the Old Testament saints will rise first and then those who are alive and remaining will be

caught up together with them. This is the bride of Christ. If you have a problem believing Jesus can appear in the air and not step foot on this earth and carry off this event, then you have a problem believing in His supernaturalness.

The Second Coming is laid out in Scripture and that is when He comes back with His saints and He is riding His white horse. That is when He fights the battle of Armegeddon and pours His judgement out.

Supposed theologians tried to say that Darby got his pre-trib idea from MacDonald's vision but he had already written about it some three years prior.
