

JESUITS and the PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE – Pt 6: MACDONALD'S VISION, THE DEVIL'S WRATH

Let's hear her vision:

"It was first the awful state of the land that was pressed upon me. I saw the blindness and infatuation of the people to be very great. I felt the cry of Liberty just to be the hiss of the serpent, to drown them in perdition. It was just 'no God.' I repeated the words, Now there is distress of nations, with perplexity, the seas and the waves roaring, men's hearts failing them for fear. Now look out for the sign of the Son of Man. Here I was made to stop and cry out, O it is not known what the sign of the Son of Man is; the people of God think they are waiting, but they know not what it is. I felt this needed to be revealed, and that there was great darkness and error about it; but suddenly what it was burst upon me with a glorious light. I saw it was just the Lord himself descending from Heaven with a shout, just the glorified man, even Jesus; but that all must, as Stephen was, be filled with

the Holy Ghost, that they might look up, and see the brightness of the Father's glory. I saw the error to be, that men think that it will be something seen by the natural eye; but 'tis spiritual discernment that is needed, the eye of God in his people. Many passages were revealed, in a light in which I had not before seen them. I repeated, 'Now is the kingdom of Heaven like unto ten virgins, who went forth to meet the Bridegroom, five wise and five foolish; they that were foolish took their lamps, but took no oil with them; but they that were wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.' 'But be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is; and be not drunk with wine wherein is excess, but be filled with the Spirit.' This was the oil the wise virgins took in their vessels – this is the light to be kept burning – the light of God – that we may discern that which cometh not with observation to the natural eye. Only those who have the light of God within them will see the sign of his appearance. No need to follow them who say, see here, or see there, for his day shall be as the lightning to those in whom the living Christ is. 'Tis Christ in us that will lift us up – he is the light – 'tis only those that are alive in him that will be caught up to meet him in the air. I saw that we must be in the Spirit, that we might see spiritual things. John was in the Spirit, when he saw a throne set in Heaven. But I saw that the glory of the ministration of the Spirit had not been known. I repeated frequently, but the spiritual temple must and shall be reared, and the fullness of Christ be poured into his body, and then shall we be caught up to meet him. Oh none will be counted worthy of this calling but his body, which is the church, and which must be a candlestick all of gold. I often said, Oh the glorious inbreaking of God which is now about to burst on this earth; Oh the glorious temple which is now about to be reared, the bride adorned for her husband; and Oh what a holy, holy bride she must be, to be prepared for such a glorious bridegroom. I said, Now shall the people of God have to do with realities – now shall the glorious mystery of God in our nature be known – now shall it be known what it is for man to be glorified. I felt that the revelation of Jesus Christ had yet to be opened up – it is not knowledge about God that it contains, but it is an entering into God – I saw that there was a glorious breaking in of God to be. I felt as Elijah, surrounded with chariots of fire. I saw as it were, the spiritual temple reared, and the Head Stone brought forth with shoutings of grace, grace, unto it. It was a glorious light above the brightness of the sun that shone round about me. I felt that those who

were filled with the Spirit could see spiritual things, and feel walking in the midst of them, while those who had not the Spirit could see nothing – so that two shall be in one bed, the one taken and the other left, because the one has the light of God within while the other cannot see the Kingdom of Heaven. I saw the people of God in an awfully dangerous situation, surrounded by nets and entanglements, about to be tried, and many about to be deceived and fall. Now will THE WICKED be revealed, with all power and signs and lying wonders, so that if it were possible the very elect will be deceived – This is the fiery trial which is to try us. – It will be for the purging and purifying of the real members of the body of Jesus; but Oh it will be a fiery trial. Every soul will be shaken to the very centre. The enemy will try to shake in every thing we have believed – but the trial of real faith will be found to honour and praise and glory. Nothing but what is of God will stand. The stony-ground hearers will be made manifest – the love of many will wax cold.

I frequently said that night, and often since, now shall the awful sight of a false Christ be seen on this earth, and nothing but the living Christ in us can detect this awful attempt of the enemy to deceive – for it is with all deceivableness of unrighteousness he will work – he will have a counterpart for every part of God's truth, and an imitation for every work of the Spirit. The Spirit must and will be poured out on the church, that she may be purified and filled with God – and just in proportion as the Spirit of God works, so will he – when our Lord anoints men with power, so will he. This is particularly the nature of the trial, through which those are to pass who will be counted worthy to stand before the Son of man. There will be outward trial too, but 'tis principally temptation. It is brought on by the outpouring of the Spirit, and will just increase in proportion as the Spirit is poured out. The trial of the Church is from Antichrist. It is by being filled with the Spirit that we shall be kept. I frequently said, Oh be filled with the Spirit – have the light of God in you, that you may detect satan – be full of eyes within -be clay in the hands of the potter -submit to be filled, filled with God. This will build the temple. It is not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith the Lord. This will fit us to enter into the marriage supper of the Lamb. I saw it to be the will of God that all should be filled. But what hindered the real life of God from being received by his people, was their turning from Jesus, who is the way to the Father. They were not entering in by the door. For he is faithful who hath said, by me if any man enters in he

shall find pasture. They were bypassing the cross, through which every drop of the Spirit of God flows to us. All power that comes not through the blood of Christ is not of God.

When I say, they are looking from the cross, I feel that there is much in it – they turn from the blood of the Lamb, by which we overcome, and in which our robes are washed and made white. There are low views of God's holiness, and a ceasing to condemn sin in the flesh, and a looking from him who humbled himself, and made himself of no reputation. Oh! it is needed, much needed at present, a leading back to the cross. I saw that night, and often since, that there will be an outpouring of the Spirit on the body, such as has not been, a baptism of fire, that all the dross may be put away. Oh there must and will be such an indwelling of the living God as has not been – the servants of God sealed in their foreheads – great conformity to Jesus – his holy image seen in his people – just the bride made comely by his comeliness put upon her. This is what we are at present made to pray much for, that speedily we may all be made ready to meet our Lord in the air – and it will be. Jesus wants his bride. His desire is toward us. He that shall come, will come, and will not tarry. Amen and Amen Even so come Lord Jesus."

Her vision is all over the road. She seemed to be talking about the Second Coming because she referenced Luke 21:26 and Matt.24:30 and those are passages about the Second Coming. When she talked about the sign of the Son of Man in heaven at His Second Coming she said that only those filled with the Holy Spirit, having oil in their vessels, because the Holy Spirit is the oil, that only they would see Him. That clearly is not Biblical because the Bible says all the people of the earth will see Him and mourn. That's not believers, believers are not going to mourn, they are going to be with Him.

She talked about the anti-christ shaking and trying the church and called it "the fiery trial." She talks about the passage in Thessalonians where Paul speaks of the man of sin and meanders through all of that applying it to the church.

She said a lot of Biblical things but she mixed the timings all up. The only people who could read that and come away believing it is about a pre-trib rapture are the

ones who have not read and studied their Bibles. Those that are not led by the Holy Spirit because spiritual matters are only understood by Him.

1 Cor.2:14 – But the natural man (person without the Spirit) receiveth not (does not accept) the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them* (he cannot understand them), because they are spiritually discerned.

So I don't believe the vision she saw is accurate nor do I believe it even supports a pre-trib rapture. You must test the spirits to see what spirit was speaking or what spirit gave the vision. In this case all I had to do was compare it to God's Word.

The teaching against the pre-trib rapture that says the Jesuits came up with it, also said there is an article from The Port Blasio Herald June of 1830. Margaret MacDonald lived in Port Blasio and in April she had her vision. June of 1830 the article said that in these meetings not only were people receiving the gift of tongues but also of writing in other languages.

The writings are not Biblical. It said that they were writing in other languages. There is not mentioned in Scripture a gift of writing. satanists have what is called "automatic writing." There was also a second printing of her vision in 1861 and the things that made it sound post-trib were removed. Hmmm See all the shady things that are done to deceive us?

FALSE TEACHING SPREADING THE LIE THAT JESUITS MADE UP THE PRE-TRIB RAPTURE

I heard a teaching against the pre-trib rapture and the idea that the Jesuits made it all up. The teaching stated that it is all a lie based on Lacunza's book. That it all started with Lacunza. The teaching states that there is only one resurrection of the just and the damned at the same time. It states that to preach the pre-trib rapture then you have to separate them. Actually Paul, through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, shows us clearly there will be separate resurrections.

1 Thess.4:13-18 - But I would not have you to be ignorant (uninformed), brethren, concerning them which are asleep (the believers who had died), that ye

sorrow not, even as others which (who) have no hope. For if (since) we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus (the believers who died) will God bring with Him (Jesus). For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep (we who are still living when the Lord returns will not meet Him ahead of those that have died). For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout (with a loud commanding shout), with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God (with the trumpet call of God): and the dead in Christ shall rise first (they will come up out of their graves): Then we which are alive *and* remain (on the earth) shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord (we will be with the Lord forever). Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

This is the rapture. Notice this does not mention unbelievers or the damned. This is spoken to the church in Thessalonica and the dead IN CHRIST are raised first and then we which are alive and remain, speaking of the Christians who will be alive at that time. There is no mention of raising anyone here who does not believe in Jesus. Right there you can see there is more than 1 resurrection. This is not the Second Coming because for that event we are already with the Lord. If we are already with Him, then you have to back up and figure out when we got with Him. That is the rapture.

The thought of one general resurrection on the same day at the same hour for believers and unbelievers is not Biblical.

Also, remember they believed in a general resurrection at that time. So you have to look at why were they worried about the ones who had already died? If they knew they would all be raised then why were they worried? It was only because of the rapture event that they were concerned about the ones who had already died. Then Paul explains that the dead in Christ will rise first, and that the ones who are still alive at that time would not stop or hinder them from being raised, and that those who are still alive would be caught up together with them. And he

says to comfort one another with these words. This is the pre-trib rapture event that is being spoken of here and not just a general resurrection.

CLOSING

The false teaching says you have to separate the resurrection to preach pretrib. You have to separate the resurrection to teach the millennial reign. That teaching states that both are false because Jesus did not teach this.

Jesus did speak about the rapture, one taken and one left and He told us about going to prepare a place for us so that He could come again and receive us unto Himself. He told us no one knows the day or the hour but His Father. The prophets of God spoke of the millennial reign and Isaiah had much to say on the subject. The Bible makes it clear that there is more than just a general resurrection. You have to look at all the scriptures instead of jumping to conclusions or just believing someone who says they are a minister or teacher of God's Word. The Bible talks of a resurrection of the just and a resurrection of the damned or unbelievers. (Daniel 12:2 / John 5:29)

Some say we must go through much tribulation to enter into the Kingdom. That is in the book of Acts (14:22). I'm having mine now. Jesus said that we would have many trials and tribulations (John 16:33) but to take heart because He had overcome the world. The Bible tells us from cover to cover that we will have many trials, tribulations and temptations. (James 1:2, 1 Peter 1:6, John 16:33) If you are a real Christian you are having yours right now. Satan hates real Christians and he fights against them. If you don't read your Bible every day, you pray now and then, you give sometimes and you would be uncomfortable praising God and haven't figured out how to use your talents to serve in His Kingdom, then you aren't having tribulations. The devil has you in his grip already.

WRATH

1 Thess.1:10 – And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom He (God) raised from the dead, even Jesus, which (Who) delivered us from the wrath to come (He is the One Who has rescued us from the terrors of the coming judgement).

There are those that say that the first part of the tribulation is the devil's wrath. He rules the world, he empowers the antichrist and the false prophet and beheads all those who will not bow to him and worship him. They say we must face the devil's wrath. And that we are raptured before God's wrath which is the last part of the tribulation which they call the great tribulation.

People can really work up some false teachings and get things all twisted around.

1 Thess.1:10 says we are delivered from the wrath to come. It did not talk about a difference in the devil's wrath or God's wrath but it simply stated that we are delivered from all wrath. Believe God's Word.
