JESUITS and the PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE – Pt 7: MILLENIAL REIGN, JUDGEMENT

Lacunza figured out that we are not already in the millennial reign. He did not understand about a pre-trib rapture. But he did understand that the Bible says that Jesus was going to come and he understood that there was going to be a 1000 year span of time before the final judgement which is called the Great White Throne Judgement. He seemed to really deal with the fact that there will be a literal 1000 reign of Christ. And he also dealt with the timing of judgments.

In volume 1 page 59 He says the theologians of old thought there was only 1 general resurrection. Millenarians were so frowned on that you dare not go against the common doctrine of the theologians of the time for fear of being called a heretic.

This is how they controlled and kept people in line with their lies. The so called Millenarians back then held crazy beliefs. So the Roman Catholic Church and the theologians at that time threw the Millenial Reign out completely and if you taught on it or believed in it then you were considered a heretic. One group of millenarians believed in a 1000 year reign but that it would not be on this earth. Another group of Millenarians believed that the law would be reinstated and circumcision would come back. This belief is from the Jews and seems to fit with sacrifices being reinstated. (Vol.1 Pg 69) However is that truly in Scripture? The Jews are going to love the antichrist and they will be having their third temple and making their sacrifices and all of that, trying to go and live back under the law during the tribulation. That part is true. They never acknowledged Jesus and they can't wait to get the law reinstated. Take a peek at The Noahide Laws and the Abrahamic Accord to see their plans to do just that.

There were some Millenarians who believed in a time of peace and prosperity on the earth. From what I can gather they believed those here on the earth at that time would be blessed materially and have excess to the point of being sinful. None of these views are what the Bible teaches and not what we generally believe about a millennial reign today. So Lacunza was venturing out to state what he believed about the Millenial reign after the Roman Catholic Church had already made their ruling about it.

And for the record, I don't stand with the so called theologians of our time. They are all witches and false teachers. They practice all of the pagan days and don't stand against them and never speak about the Mandela Effect, nor true repentance and obedience and the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Instead, I study God's Word, pray on it, sometimes I talk with Pastor Erustus about different things and am led by the Holy Spirit. By their standards I would be called a heretic. Remember God's true prophets were murdered and treated cruelly all through time by the "religious" crowd.

The idea that there is only one general resurrection is solved when you realize the Bible talks about Jesus' return before the millennial reign. And because we know it says the dead in Christ shall rise first and we which are alive and remain will be caught up together with them to meet the Lord in the air and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Just look at the resurrection part. This is a resurrection only involving the righteous. And with this resurrection are those that are still alive – all caught up or snatched up in an instant. Then the tribulation. Next is the Second Coming and we are with Jesus because we had already gone to be with Him. There is a resurrection at the end of the tribulation, of the tribulation saints, called the 1st resurrection. The Christians that died during the tribulation are resurrected at the Second Coming after the battle of Armageddon. Those in the first resurrection also get to rule and reign with Christ for a 1000 years. Which begins after the judgment of the nations which takes place in The Valley of Jehoshaphat. Then comes the 1000 year reign. Then at the end of that will be the Great White Throne Judgement where all the unbelievers will be judged. That's another resurrection and seems like the ones who lived through the 1000 year reign will be judged there too.

In Lacunza's book, Vol. 1 pg. 76 He speaks of a general resurrection which many early church theologians placed after the 1000 year reign. Then in Vol.2 pg. 356 He speaks of a universal resurrection and so this universal resurrection or general

resurrection that they believed in at that time seems to be The Great White Throne Judgment. That was one of the issues he was dealing with as well was the timing of the judgments. He knew we would be with Christ so a general or universal judgment does not fit in that case.

Rev.20:1-4 - And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season. And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

This is when the millennial reign will take place.

John 5:28-29 – Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

This talks of all being raised but it does not specify that it is at the same time. This false teaching said that everyone is raised and judged at the same time and that the rapture and the millennial reign are both false because Jesus did not teach them. Jesus spoke on the rapture, Paul certainly was given that revelation and taught on it. Isaiah and John were certainly given revelation about the millennial reign and they are God's prophets.

THE LAST DAY

John 11:27 - She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

John 6:40 - And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

God works His plan the way He chooses and He chose to reveal the rapture through Paul. Paul was taught directly by Jesus for 3 years. (Gal.1:11-12, 15-18) That is why you don't see Jesus teach on the rapture or speak much about it. It wasn't God's time to reveal it yet. The disciples were not understanding what Jesus meant about how He was going to die and rise again the 3rd day. Maybe they needed to see Jesus resurrect first, to help them to believe and understand better before telling them about the rapture.

So the phrase "at the last day" was consistent with the knowledge they had at that time, of a general resurrection.

This false teaching says that the pre-trib idea went from Lacunza to Irving, who translated his book, to Darby who taught it. It said an invisible coming of the Lord is impossible but never said what that's based on. God can do anything, He is not limited in any way. God is Sovereign, He holds all supernatural power and He is not limited in any way. Our minds may not be able to grasp some things in His Word but that doesn't make it a lie. Many people get hung up in trying to explain Biblical things through science and you can explain a lot of it through science but not all of it. Be careful to remember God is supernatural and He can do anything even if we can't understand it.

MY THOUGHTS ON LACUNZA'S BOOK

Remember this book is supposed to be the big premise for how the pre-trib rapture teaching got started. Looking over Volume 1 What I saw was a bunch of talk about Jesus' Second Coming and at that time, raising the dead saints and those yet alive to rule and reign with Him for 1000 years which he equated with the 1st resurrection. That is not the pre-trib rapture. Over and over again he seemed to be proving a point that there would be a Millennial Kingdom on this earth.

He did not mention the rapture, or the harpazo or the catching away at all. In fact on pages 274 & 275 he says that he does not believe in any "secret coming" but says many dr's do: Arduino & Berruyer. He seemed to speak of the Second Coming only and the fact that there will be 1000 years between that and the Great White Throne Judgment.

FALSE TEACHING THEORIES AND LOOSE ENDS

In the research I did, they say that Jesus will not return until He comes to deal with His enemies and that is when He comes on His white horse.

They do not understand that He is not coming to receive His bride and judge the world all at the same time. When He comes bringing judgement, it is the Second Coming. That is totally different than when He comes to receive His bride.

1 Peter 4:17 - For the time *is come* that judgment must begin at the house of God: and if *it* first *begin* at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?

The pre-trib rapture starts with God's House. Those that have watched and prayed and are worthy will be taken. That is a judgment and as well it is a judgment against those remaining to realize they were left and now will be in terror on this earth with their necks on the line to shed their own blood to have salvation if they believe in Jesus in their hearts at that time.

Acts 3:19-21 — Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; And He shall send Jesus Christ, which (Who) before was preached unto you: Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began.

The false teaching says that Jesus is not coming back until He comes to restore all things.

Jesus will come and receive His Bride before He deals with His enemies because there is no condemnation to them who are in Christ and we are not assigned to God's wrath.

We will ride with Him:

Rev.17:14 – These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him *are* called, and chosen, and faithful.

This is before the beast or antichrist and false prophet are thrown into the lake of fire. It is before the end of the tribulation because Jesus is about to fight the battle of Armageddon. It is before the Millenial Reign because this is during a war and the Millenial Reign is a time of peace. And take note that we are with Him. The holy angels were never called or chosen. They have remained faithful but not called and chosen. The called and chosen ones are the bride of Christ and we are riding with Christ at His return.

Rev.19:14 – And the armies *which were* in heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

We are soldiers in the army of Jesus Christ. (2 Tim.2:3) The angels are in His army also and I believe they are included here.

Zech.14:5 – And ye shall flee *to* the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, *and* all the saints with thee.

This is about the Second Coming and we are with Jesus here when He comes. We are already with Him.

Jude 14 - And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of His saints,

The word saints here is the greek word hagios. The meaning includes being morally blameless, separated from sin and consecrated to God. This is not talking about angels for they are not sanctified, we are.

CLOSING

SATAN'S PREPARATION FOR THE RAPTURE

Remember Project Blue Beam and the teaching series I did on that. The luciferians have been prepping and setting up the skies for their big deception to try and fool the ones that will be left behind. They have been working on what they are going to say and do when Jesus removes His bride. The blue beam coming from our technology and our new fangled head lights hitting us in the brain to trigger the nano technology to keep us plugged in to the artificial intelligence system or satan's hive mind. There are many people today that have it all backwards and they believe those of us striving to be counted worthy are wimps and that the strong ones and the ones really doing something for Jesus are the ones going into the tribulation. That is completely opposite from the Word of God. My life is on the line because of the work that I am doing for the Lord right now. I'm standing up here by His hand upon me. I trust in Him to preserve me until it is my time to go and be with Him.

Some say, the Bible talks about persevering to the end and it does. Did King David not persevere to the end? Did the early Apostles not persevere to the end? Remember Paul said he had fought an excellent fight, he finished his race and kept the faith (2 Tim.4:7-8). Surely he persevered to the end. We are to persevere, running our race and fighting the good fight and keep the faith until we go to be with Jesus. Everyone has an end, let's be faithful right up to the end.

Many people talk tough, but when push comes to shove and they are facing the razor sharp blade of the guillotine, they won't stand up to it. Not without the baptism of the Holy Spirit, they won't. Now is the time to be saved and living an obedient life so that you can be counted worthy to be the bride of Christ.
