JESUITS and the PRE-TRIBULATION RAPTURE – Pt 9: DEPARTING AWAY, CONSEQUENCES FOR NOT BELIEVING GOD'S WORD

Short on Bitchute – Exposing Corona virus vaccines part 4.

Sister Linda made a comment on last week's message and said that those believing we are supposed to go into the rapture so that we can do something for Jesus and so that we can die for Him – that is a work's based theology. And when you try to make the rapture about the church you are believing in replacement theology – which is a belief that the church has replaced Israel and the Jews. And you put the focus on the church. The focus during the tribulation is on Israel and the Jews. That's why we read about 144,000 Jews being sealed and why God sends His 2 witnesses which we believe are Jews so that the Jewish people can come out of their blindness. Remember they were blinded (Romans 11:25) so that the nations could come and be saved. Those who refused the love of the truth (2 Thess.2:9-12) will be dealt with in the tribulation as well.

Even though God is merciful to still save people during the tribulation, don't think it is going to be easy. For those that were not saved, means they did not receive the love of the truth and the Bible says that God Himself will send them strong delusion so that they all might be damned. Because they did not receive the truth about salvation and come and be saved and love and serve Christ obediently. Those that are putting it off thinking I'll just get saved then, you might not even live that long. And if you can't even get saved now, seriously, what chance do you think you'll have then with even God sending you strong delusion?

Back in 1830 they believed the apostasy was the falling away from the truth of the pure gospel.

Thomas Scott: **It is manifest that no succession of men has appeared on earth to whom this description fully accords except that of the Roman pontiffs.** They have opposed the truths, the apostles and Disciples of Christ. This man of sin sits

as god in the temple of god and we must look for him in the visible church. The Roman pontiff claiming to be the head of the whole church on earth.

This was a good point about the succession of wicked popes because the Bible talks about 7 kings leading up to the 8th and he is of the 7.

Rev.17:11 - And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.

New Living Translation

"The scarlet beast that was, but is no longer, is the eighth king. He is like the other seven, and he, too, is headed for destruction.

Think of it as a killing machine shedding blood – the scarlet beast, making laws and implementing plans that are designed purposely against Christ and His church all down through time. Even now we see the world leaders in agreement carrying out this corona virus agenda. They are all alike because they all serve the same one, satan, and carry out his plans. That is why this 8th king is just like the others. Just like Nero, Hitler, Stalin, Mussolini etc. all murdering dictators.

We have presidents in succession, kings and queens in succession and way more than 7 or 8 popes by now. They are all wicked. The pope still looks like a good candidate for the false prophet since he is playing a religious role and is situated in Rome. Rome was the one in power who destroyed Jerusalem and the last temple in 70 a.d.

When the false teaching mentions the apostasy they are referring to 2 Thess.2:3. Let's take a look at it:

2 Thess.2:3 - Let no one deceive you by any means; for *that Day will not come* unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin (the man of lawlessness) is revealed, the son of perdition (the one who brings destruction),

Many old Bibles said "Departure Away:" 400 – Jerome's Latin Vulgate, 1384 Wycliff, 1526 Tyndale, 1535 Coverdale, 1539 Kranmar, 1576 Rega, 1583 Beza, and the 1608 Geneva Bible. They spoke differently back then than we do today. The languages have been evolving. When you hear falling away that does not cause you to think of Jesus taking His bride. It makes you think people fell away from the faith. But if you hear that a departure away takes place first, then that makes more sense, of those in Christ departing away from this world first and then the man of sin will be revealed. King James was the first translation to change from departure or departing away to falling away and no reason was given. When Paul was ready to die he said the time of his departure was at hand. (2 Tim.4:6 / Phil.1:23). He was speaking of his spirit departing from this world. That is the right way to think of what is really being said there. There will be a departing or departure away of the bride of Christ. They have tampered with our translations to make it hard to know the truth.

Rev. 3:10 - Because thou hast kept the word of My patience (Because you have kept My command to endure patiently), I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation (hour of testing or trial), which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

The Interlinear Bible says I will also keep you "Out of the hour." Real Christians will be removed because we have already endured testing and been found worthy to escape what's coming on this earth. It is a reward from God to the bride of Christ to remove her or for her to escape. Many people have gotten it twisted now and they believe the honor is to go into the tribulation and shed your own blood for Jesus. That is not what God wants for His church. Some say, Noah did not get removed, he stayed on the earth but was protected in the ark. And the rationing is that we must all stay. However, no one is going to be protected during the tribulation and that is why God sends Jesus to remove the church. The 144,000 will be sealed with God's Spirit, that is salvation, but they will still be in danger of their lives through beheading. When Jesus says that His coming will be as in the days of Noah, He is speaking of the element of surprise. The Bible says they were eating and drinking and marrying and giving in marriage (Matt.24:38). It was life as usual and then all of a sudden in an instant everything changes. Think about Lott, God did not destroy Sodom and Gomorrah until Lott and his family were safely out.

CLOSING

There are many things that are plainly taught in the Bible that are disputed. The Trinity is disputed. There are those that say the Trinity is a false teaching. What do you do when you hear things like this? First of all, you always read and study God's Word for yourself. You pray about things you are unsure of or don't understand. And you listen to sound teaching, test the spirits to see what spirit the minister or teacher is speaking by. Does it line up with God's Word?

It is easy for these false teachers to plant doubt and they leave the burden of proof on someone else while they waltz out of the room. It is the same with an atheist saying God does not exist and the poor Christians have worked themselves silly trying to prove that God does exist. And for what? Because then they just say to all of the evidence and proof – that's not true. The Bible tells us not to engage in arguments because they profit nothing. Speak the truth and know the truth and otherwise pray for the ones who can't see it.

The pretrib rapture is a major teaching in Scripture. Some think it's no big deal not to believe in it. They think it is a win-win for them either way. They think it's ok not to believe in it and it's ok to argue against it and try to discredit those that teach it and what have you. And they think if they are wrong about it, it's no big deal because they believe they will still get to go in the rapture in spite of standing against it. Will they? There are always consequences for not believing God's Word.

2 Kings 7:1-20 - Then Elisha said, Hear ye the word of the LORD; Thus saith the LORD, Tomorrow about this time *shall* a measure of fine flour *be sold* for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, in the gate of Samaria. Then a lord on whose hand the king leaned (an officer assisting the king) answered the man of God, and said, Behold, *if* the LORD would make windows in heaven, might this thing be (That couldn't happen even if the Lord opened the windows of heaven)? And he (Elisha) said, Behold, thou shalt see *it* with thine eyes, but shalt not eat thereof. And there were four leprous men at the entering in of the gate: and they said one to another, Why sit we here until we die? If we say, We will enter into the city, then the famine *is* in the city, and we shall die there: and if we sit still here (if we stay here), we die also. Now therefore come, and let us fall unto the

host of the Syrians (army of the Arameans): if they save us alive, we shall live; and if they kill us, we shall but die. And they rose up in the twilight, to go unto the camp of the Syrians (Arameans): and when they were come to the uttermost part of the camp of Syria, behold, *there was* no man there. For the Lord had made the host (army) of the Syrians to hear a noise of chariots, and a noise of horses, *even* the noise of a great host (a great army): and they said one to another, Lo, the king of Israel hath hired against us the kings of the Hittites, and the kings of the Egyptians, to come upon us (to attack us). Wherefore they arose and fled in the twilight (dusk), and left their tents, and their horses, and their asses (donkeys), even the camp as it *was*, and fled for their life. And when these lepers came to the uttermost part of the camp, they went into one tent, and did eat and drink, and carried thence silver, and gold, and raiment (clothes), and went and hid it; and came again, and entered into another tent, and carried thence *also*, and went and hid *it*. Then they said one to another, We do not well (this is not right): this day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace (aren't sharing it): if we tarry till the morning light, some mischief will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household. So they came and called unto the porter of the city (the city gatekeepers): and they told them, saying, We came to the camp of the Syrians, and, behold, there was no man there, neither voice of man, but horses tied, and asses (donkeys) tied, and the tents as they were. And he called the porters (gatekeepers); and they told it to the king's house within. And the king arose in the night, and said unto his servants, I will now shew you what the Syrians have done to us. They know that we be hungry (we are starving); therefore are they gone out of the camp to hide themselves in the field, saying, When they come out of the city, we shall catch them alive, and get into the city. And one of his servants answered and said, Let *some* take, I pray thee, five of the horses that remain, which are left in the city, (behold, they are as all the multitude of Israel that are left in it: behold, I say, they *are* even as all the multitude of the Israelites that are consumed (doomed):) and let us send and see. They took therefore two chariot horses; and the king sent after the host of the Syrians, saying, Go and see. And they went after them unto Jordan: and, lo, all the way was full of garments and vessels, which the Syrians had cast away in their haste. And the messengers returned, and told the

king. And the people went out, and spoiled the tents of the Syrians (plundered the tents of the Syrians). So a measure of fine flour was *sold* for a shekel, and two measures of barley for a shekel, according to the word of the LORD. And the king appointed the lord on whose hand he leaned (the officer who assisted the king) to have the charge of the gate: and the people trode upon him in the gate (the people trampled him in the gate), and he died, as the man of God had said, who spake when the king came down to him. And it came to pass as the man of God had spoken to the king, saying, Two measures of barley for a shekel, and a measure of fine flour for a shekel, shall be tomorrow about this time in the gate of Samaria: And that lord (officer) answered the man of God, and said, Now, behold, *if* the LORD should make windows in heaven, might such a thing be (That couldn't happen even if the Lord opened the windows of heaven!)? And he said, Behold, thou shalt see it with thine eyes, but shalt not eat thereof. And so it fell out unto him (and so it was): for the people trode upon him in the gate (for the people trampled him in the city gate), and he died.

Let no man deceive you. Believe God's Word. No one knows when they will take their last breath, live every day ready to go be with Jesus. You may not live to see the rapture.
