

AMEN Pt 3: ANCIENT EGYPT, THEBES, OTIOT, HIEROGLYPHS, AMON, AMUN

Thebes was the capital of Egypt during the period of the New Kingdom (c.1570-c.1069 BCE) and became an important center of worship of the god Amun (also known as Amon or Amen). Its sacred name was *P-Amen* or *Pa-Amen* meaning "the abode of Amen". It was also known to the Egyptians as *Wase* or *Wo'se* (the city) and *Usast* or *Waset* (*was-et*) (the southern city) and was built on either side of the Nile River with the main city on the east bank and the vast necropolis on the west.

Here they used the spellings: a-m-o-n, a-m-e-n, and a-m-u-n all for the same false god. When I began to look into this I found this very interesting for all the different spellings that meant the same one and same thing and how far back in time it went. The worship of satan as "amen" went further back even than 1500 bc.

They are the ones that have taught the world the otiot, that every letter has a picture. This is part of their otiot. Look at the top row from l to r it shows an upside down candy cane and a picture of a bull, it says this means strong leader and in Hebrew they say it is a name for God meaning "strength." It is used 250 times in their Tanakh which is another of their witchcraft books filled with lies. The bottom row shows a symbol you see all over Egypt and again the picture of the bull. 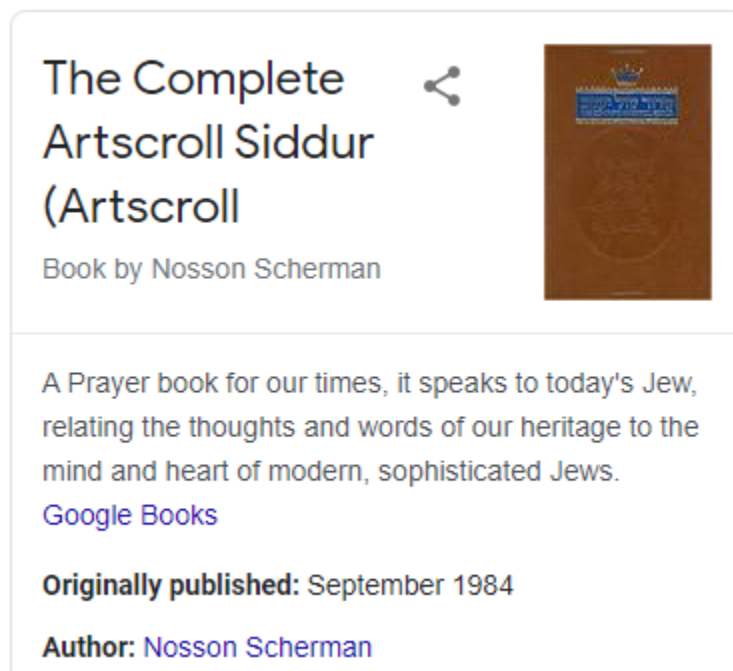
