There are some denominations that do not believe it is ok for women to wear jewelry. I am always amazed at how those religions convince their parishioners to go along with this type of stuff. I think those people are just trusting what they are being told and not reading and studying the Bible for themselves. Those that teach against it are cherry picking verses and not teaching in context. We have already gone over the passages in 1 Timothy and 1 Peter that advise women to be modest in their appearance. Jewelry is not forbidden but Scripture advises us to be known for our inner godly beauty rather than by outward appearance. We are to avoid exaggerations of any sort.

This next passage of scripture is about the time of the Exodus when the Israelites plundered the Egyptians.

Exodus 12:35-36 - And the children of Israel did according to the word of Moses; and they borrowed (they asked) of the Egyptians jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: And the LORD gave the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent (gave) unto them *such things as they required* (whatever they asked for). And they spoiled the Egyptians (they stripped the Egyptians of their wealth).

This was God's way of letting them take the spoils of war without having to fight for them. God sent them out with a blessing in hand. If God had a problem with jewelry, they certainly would not have been asking for the jewels of silver and

gold. They did not lend them because they never wanted to see the Israelites again. They gladly gave them everything because they just wanted to get rid of them at that point.

The next passage of scripture is just after the Israelites had been delivered out of slavery in Egypt and Moses had gone up on the mountain to receive the ten commandments from God. The people were so impatient and quickly were turning back to the idolatry they had learned from the Egyptians.

Exodus 32:2 – And Aaron said unto them, Break off (take off) the golden earrings, which *are* in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring *them* unto me.

So you can see that they were wearing golden earrings. It mentions everyone wearing them except the men.

The women might reasonably have been expected to resist, and the men to yield before such resistance; but the event proved otherwise.

I had not heard this theory before and it seems possible. Aaron might have thought they would resist. The way it reads in the Bible, it seems like Aaron was a pushover and went right to work making an idol for them and he was God's high priest. He was brand new and at this point, he needed to be more bold and to stand against the people and stand in God's ways. He was a pleasing man in what he did and not God.

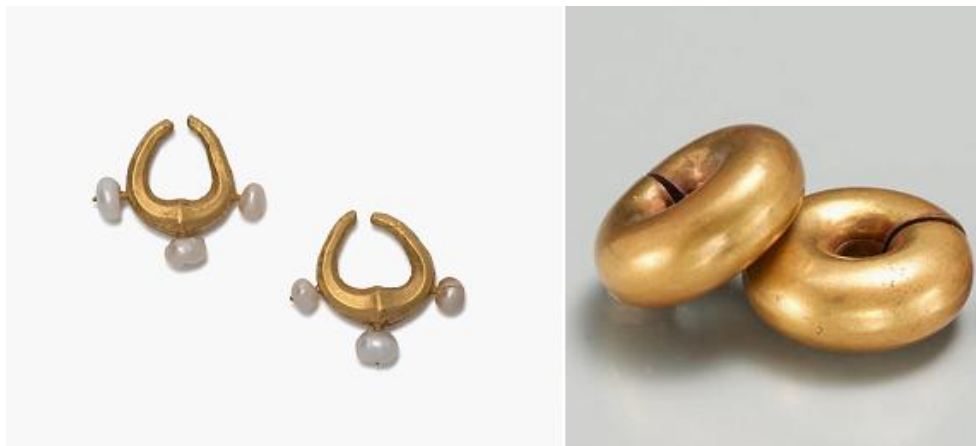

These are the type of earrings being described, penannular earrings just sort of clip onto the ear but do not penetrate through the earlobe.

Ezekiel 16:1-24, 36-39 – Again the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, cause Jerusalem to know her abominations (detestable practices / sins), And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD unto Jerusalem; Thy birth and thy nativity *is* of the land of Canaan; thy father *was* an Amorite, and thy mother an Hittite. And *as for* thy nativity, in the day thou wast born thy navel was not cut, neither wast thou washed in water to supple *thee*; thou wast not salted at all, nor swaddled at all (wrapped in cloths). None eye pitied thee, to do any of these unto thee, to have compassion upon thee; but thou wast cast out in the open field, to the lothing of thy person, in the day that thou wast born (you were unwanted, dumped in a field and left to die). And when I passed by thee, and saw thee polluted in thine own blood (laying in your own blood), I said unto thee *when thou wast* in thy blood, Live; yea, I said unto thee *when thou wast* in thy blood, Live. I have caused thee to multiply (grow) as the bud (plant) of the field, and thou hast increased and waxen great (you grew up), and thou art come to excellent ornaments (you became a beautiful jewel): *thy* breasts are fashioned (your breasts became full), and thine hair is grown (your hair has grown), whereas thou *wast* naked and bare (you were still naked). Now (Later) when I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, thy time *was* the time of love (you were old enough for love); and I spread My skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness (I spread the corner of My garment over you to cover your nakedness): yea, I swore unto thee (I declared My marriage vows), and entered into a covenant with thee , saith the Lord GOD, and thou becamest Mine. Then washed I thee with water; yea, I thoroughly washed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil. I clothed thee also with broidered work (with an embroidered dress), and shod thee with badgers' skin (with shoes of fine goatskin leather), and I girded thee about with fine linen, and I covered thee with silk (costly garments). I decked thee also with ornaments (I gave you beautiful jewelry), and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and a chain on thy neck. And I put a jewel on thy forehead, and earrings in thine ears, and a beautiful crown upon thine head. Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment *was of* fine linen, and silk (costly fabrics), and broidered work (beautiful embroidery); thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and (olive) oil: and thou wast exceeding beautiful, and thou didst prosper into a kingdom (You looked like a queen and so you were). And thy renown went forth among the heathen (the world) for thy beauty: for it *was* perfect through

My comeliness (My beauty), which I had put upon thee, saith the Lord GOD. But thou didst trust in thine own beauty (you thought your beauty was your own), and playedst the harlot because of thy renown (you became a prostitute because of your fame), and pouredst out thy fornications on every one that passed by (You gave yourself as a prostitute to every man who came along); his it was (your beauty became his). And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon (You used the lovely things I gave you to make shrines for idols where you prostituted yourself): *the like things* shall not come, neither shall it be so (Unbelievable! How could such a thing ever happen?). Thou hast also taken thy fair jewels of My gold and of My silver, which I had given thee, and madest to thyself images of men (statues of men or male idols), and didst commit whoredom (prostitution) with them, And tookest thy broidered garments, and coveredst them: and thou hast set mine oil and mine incense before them (offered the oil and incense that God had given them, offered it to idols). My meat (food) also which I gave thee, fine flour, and (olive) oil, and honey, *wherewith* I fed thee, thou hast even set it before them for a sweet savour (you offered it for a sacrifice): and *thus* it was, saith the Lord GOD. Moreover thou hast taken thy sons and thy daughters, whom thou hast borne unto Me, and these hast thou sacrificed unto them to be devoured (you sacrificed them to your gods). *Is this* of thy whoredoms a small matter (Was your prostitution not enough?), That thou hast slain My children (you slaughtered My children), and delivered them to cause them to pass through *the fire* for them? And in all thine abominations (in all your detestable practices) and thy whoredoms (prostitutions) thou hast not remembered the days of thy youth, when thou wast naked and bare, *and* wast polluted in thy blood (kicking about in your own blood). And it came to pass after all thy wickedness, (woe, woe unto thee! saith the Lord GOD;) *That* thou hast also built unto thee an eminent place (an arch, a raised platform or a mound for prostitution), and hast made thee an high place (for ritual prostitution) in every street (in Jerusalem).

v.36-39 - Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thy filthiness (your lust) was poured out, and thy nakedness discovered (you exposed your naked body) through thy whoredoms (prostitutions) with thy lovers, and with all the idols of thy abominations (with all your detestable idols), and by the blood of thy children, which thou didst give unto them; Behold, therefore I will gather all thy lovers (your allies), with whom thou hast taken pleasure (with whom you have sinned), and all *them* that thou hast loved, with all *them* that thou hast hated; I will even

gather them round about against thee, and will discover thy nakedness unto them (I will strip you bare), that they may see all thy nakedness. And I will judge thee, as women that break wedlock (commit adultery) and shed blood (commit murder) are judged; and I will give thee blood in fury and jealousy (I will cover you with blood in My jealous fury). And I will also give thee into their hand (I will give you to your lovers), and they shall throw down thine eminent place (mound or raised platform for prostitution), and shall break down thy high places (your pagan altars and shrines): they shall strip thee also of thy clothes, and shall take thy fair jewels, and leave thee naked and bare.

Where it says, I gave a jewel for your forehead...all of the other translations say that was a ring for her nose. **Just because that is there, let me remind you of the demons that were manifesting in the lady at Pastor Erustus' church. She could not get delivered until Pastor Erustus removed her nose ring. I gave my testimony of having a nose piercing in the teaching I did on piercings. God saw to it that I removed it.**

This chapter in Ezekiel shows the love the LORD has for Jerusalem, and how He adorned her. He gave her lavish gifts and fine clothes and beautiful jewels and jewelry. He gave her the best and He made her beautiful. When it says He spread His garment over her, that was what a man did when he betrothed a woman to be his wife. That is a picture of God stating that He is the husband of Israel. Jeremiah 3:8 talks about God divorcing her because she cheated on Him time and time again.

He made her beautiful but she cheated on Him, so in judgment He took it all away. When He tells them their birth or nativity is from Caanan, this is in a spiritual sense that God is speaking. They were serving the fallen angels of the Caananites and not serving God. It is comparable to when Jesus told the Pharisees they were of their father the devil. This was based on their actions.

CLOSING

God mentioned so many things that He had blessed the nation of Israel with. He had lavished her with beautiful things from head to toe. He is not against all of these things, jewelry, fine clothes or beautiful clothes, pretty hair and nice accessories. He was angry about their serving the fallen angels and not Him and so He took it all away. They were even using what He had blessed them with to

go and serve the fallen angels and offer it up to them. God said, enough is enough – that's it! He took all those things away as a punishment for their sin. Who gave them all those beautiful things in the first place? He did. So no, God is not against jewelry and nice things as long as we are being modest in our appearance.
