

MEN'S HAIR and BEARDS

As a man, you should not have long hair. In the Bible, it was those that were under a Nazarite vow who let their hair grow long. Like Samson.



Samson and Delilah. Numbers chapter 6 speaks about the vow of a Nazarite in not cutting his or her hair.

Lev.19:27 - Ye shall not round the corners of your heads (do not cut the hair at the sides of your head so as to make your hair round), neither shalt thou mar (clip off) the corners of thy beard (the edges of your beard).

Ellicott's Commentary for English Readers


(27) Round the corners of your heads.—That is, they are not to shave off the hair around the temples and behind the ears, so as to leave the head bald except a dish-like tuft upon the crown, thus imparting to their heads the form of a hemisphere. This was done by the Arabs, and other worshippers of the god Orotal. Hence the Arabs are ironically called "those with the corner of their hair polled," as it is rightly rendered in the Margin (Jeremiah 9:26; Jeremiah 25:23; Jeremiah 49:32).

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
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
Once again we see here that the pagans were cutting their hair in a certain way to worship the fallen angels. God forbid His children to cut their hair like that.



So the Kabalistic Jews have taken the verse that stated not to cut the hair at the sides of your head and made it into a perverted ritual of their own. Growing these curly ques from the sides of their head had nothing to do with what God said. Total non-sense.

And they bring their children up in this perversion against God too.

Mar the corners of thy beard.—The beard was regarded by the Hebrews and other eastern nations as the greatest ornament of a man, and was as dear to them as life itself. It was the object of salutation (2Samuel 20:9), and the mutilation of it was looked upon as the greatest disgrace and most degrading punishment (2Samuel 10:4; Isaiah 7:20; Ezra 5:1-5, &c.). It was only in seasons of sorrow that the Hebrews neglected their beards; and sometimes, to show how deeply they were afflicted, they covered them up, or even cut them off, or tore them out (2Samuel 19:24; Isaiah 15:2; Jeremiah 41:5, &c.). Because it was so precious a treasure, it was customary among some of the ancients to present to their gods the firstlings of their beards. The prohibition before us alludes to this practice. . . .

Back to our commentary: Remember the verse in Leviticus said for them not to clip off the corners of their beards. That sounds strange. Didn't God want them to maintain the situation?

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Now we see again, that the pagans were worshipping the fallen angels by trimming off parts of their beards and offering them to their gods. Our God told

the Israelites not to be doing those things. He wanted His children to be holy as He is holy and to stay out of pagan practices.

Isaiah 7:20 - In the same day shall the Lord shave with a rasor that is hired, *namely*, by them beyond the river, by the king of Assyria, the head, and the hair of the feet: and it shall also consume the beard.

They wore beards back then and God was going to use the king of Assyria to shave off all the hair of their body, including their beards. They would be utterly defeated and put to shame.

Isaiah 15:1-2 – The burden of Moab (A prophecy against Moab). Because in the night Ar of Moab is laid waste, *and* brought to silence; because in the night Kir of Moab is laid waste (destroyed), *and* brought to silence; He is gone up (Your people are gone up) to Bajith, and to Dibon, the high places, to weep: Moab shall howl over Nebo, and over Medeba: on all their heads *shall be* baldness, *and* every beard cut off.

When God judged them, He said they would shave off their hair and beards in mourning for their god, Nebo and for the city of Medeba.

Isaiah 50:6 - I gave My back to the smiters, and My cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

Isaiah prophecied this about Jesus. For the men out there, can you imagine the pain of having your beard plucked out? He did even that for us. He took it all and said nothing in return.



I cannot imagine dealing with all of that hair. Remember we learned that one reason women would cut their hair off was because of lice. Can you imagine getting an infestation of lice in that hair? Now I get a better idea of the woman who cried tears on Jesus' feet and wiped them dry with her hair. I couldn't imagine most women today trying to dry Jesus' feet with their hair but this hair makes more sense.

God never said we cannot cut our hair. We do not have to veil our heads. We are to be subjective to our husbands and to please them. There are a lot of women living in bondage because of what was said to the Corinthian church regarding their customs and traditions of that time.

Paul was teaching the Corinthians how to serve and worship God. They had just come out of the pagan religion worshipping the fallen angels. The Jews prayed with covered heads, but the Greeks did not. There were many questions as to whether the women should cover their hair with a veil or put it up on their heads or even to cut it or not. The end of that teaching was that the Apostles nor God's churches had any such customs.

For a woman, if you want to grow your hair long and not cut it, you can. However, if you want to cut your hair, you can do that too. If you want to wear a head covering in church, you can but if you don't want to, you don't have to.

Are these things important to God? Are we impressing God with all of the elaborate hairstyles? How much time do you spend on your appearance? I remember when I was single and I had longer hair, it would take at least an hour just on my hair. And that was not even elaborate hair.

Have you given thought to people with severe arthritis or diseases that hinder their ability to do their hair? Surely God loves them just as much.

With my rheumatoid arthritis there have been times that it has been very hard for me to wash even my short hair and just as hard to try to blow dry it and fix it. There have been times I have had to get Scott to blow dry it for me because the pain in my hands was so severe. What about people who have gone through chemo and have lost their hair? God loves them still. If a woman has long hair it is her crowning glory just as my short hair is my crowning glory. God does not judge us on our hair or outward appearance.

In different situations, like losing your hair because of cancer, you might wear a wig. I know a woman who lost her very long beautiful hair because of cancer. After that, Sister Margaret, wore some cute wigs as her hair was growing back in. I will say this, if you wear a wig or hair extensions or a weave of any sort – pray over them first. Bind and cast out any demonic attachments, curses, spells – witchcraft and cast it out in Jesus' name. Cover them in the blood of Jesus. Ask God to place His blessing on it because it is being used for His servant. There is a war against Christians and they are doing witch craft over these type of things, placing curses and spells on them and even demons attached to them.

Last of all, let's remember this next very important thing about God:

1 Samuel 16:7b - for *the LORD seeth* not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the LORD looketh on the heart.

Let's not get so caught up in our appearance that we lose sight of how God sees us.
