MAASAI LAND

The rest of this update is about the newly planted church in The Maasai Land on the border of Tanzania. I want to share some things I left out of the last update about the first trip Pastor took to The Maasai Land.

Pastor shared: The mission was very successful, we had 2 days teaching sessions, night revival sessions and a very powerful Sunday service. Gods power moved so powerfully touching many lives. Receive greetings!!!

We had a good time with Pastors and the key leaders. We were welcomed with love and these people for sure love God. It's one of the tribes in Kenya that live in the arid areas, many have no education, still living old traditional life, unreached with the gospel, poor and live a nomadic life. No vehicles we used motor bikes to move into the villages on very dusty roads where the churches are. We now have 4 branch churches under our ministry. I give glory to God.

Where the main church is build it's a rented land. My visitation was fruitful, God touched one of the brothers in church who donated a 4 acre piece of land . Now the leaders decided here is where the headquarters of our ministry will be build for our Maasai land ministry work, it's just next to piped water and a passable road on its lower part. Thank you Jesus!!!

The other 3 branch churches are in different locations in the remote villages.

January 10th:

We thank God for enabling us to buy 15 plastic chairs for our Holy Trinity Living Water church at Kimana, Oloitokitok in Maasai land. They are holding their services under a tree on the donated 4 hactres land. They need more plastic chairs as God provides. Thank you Bishop David for your great support!

We are trusting God to provide \$960 to enable us build a church structure on this land where they can hold church meetings safe from the hot sun and rains.
