

This is an example of a person seeking a witch (here called a shaman) to heal or help them with answers through divination. Shamans are witches and they do use drugs in their witchcraft.



Think about vision quests and Indian sweat lodges where the person gets so dehydrated and delirious and high on whatever potion or drug they take that they begin to hallucinate and have visions. This process is so that they could receive

inner revelation to know the meaning of their life. They believe the world and its natural elements are controlled by spirits. In their religious belief system they worship animals, plants, wind, water etc. Native American Indians that hold true to their native beliefs do not serve Jesus. When you hear of the great spirit, that they worship, that has nothing to do with Jesus or The Father.

Power Animals


Definition of Power Animals: What are Power Animals? Power Animals are strongly associated with the Native American Indian belief in Animism that is a belief based on the spiritual idea that the universe, and all natural objects within the universe, have souls or spirits. Power Animals are believed to be a supernatural power that embodies, attaches or conveys influence empowering a person with the powerful traits and characteristics of the animal. The doctrine of this belief is that everything is alive, and possesses an inherent virtue, power and wisdom. Power animals represent a person's connection to all life, their qualities of character, and their power. Power Animals are regarded as guides who appear in dreams or Vision Quests in the form of an animal. Power Animals, or spirit guides, walk through different stages of life with a person, teaching and guiding them, and in some instances protecting them.

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What is being described here is a demon. The practices of Native American Indians is idolatry. They are interacting with demons in visions and dreams etc. The things they are shown are from the fallen angels. They are being taught and guided by them. Interacting spiritually with animal spirits reminds me of witches who have familiars that they work with. A demon inside of an animal.

A Vision Quest is a spiritual journey to enlightenment. It allows the individual that drinks the potion to go into a magical slumber to seek the answers they are looking for. Until the answer is found, the drinker cannot wake up.

Vision quest, supernatural experience in which an individual seeks to interact with a guardian spirit, usually an anthropomorphized animal, to obtain advice or protection. Vision quests were most typically found among the <u>native</u> peoples of North and South America.

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This guardian spirit they wanted to interact with is an evil spirit, a fallen angel. This is the same thing as what happens in new age with spirit guides. They are all demons no matter what name you tag them with.

Power Animals - Spiritual Energy

Power Animals are the spiritual energy of the animal on earth. Power Animals are greater than the actual animals because they embody the spirit and essence of the animal. For instance with a bear power animal, it is the voice of all the bears that have ever lived. It is the Medicine Bear. It is the bear that can see itself and speak. The spirit of Power Animals also lends you the wisdom of its kind. An owl spirit will give you owl wisdom, and lend you some of the attributes of owl. Power Animals will often appear to the Medicine Man, or Shaman, as a vision during a Vision Quest and these Power Animals are adopted as a guardian spirit and teacher. Power Animals form part of the belief in Shamanism but also appear in the dreams of individuals.

Identifying Power Animals – Vision Quests

Power Animals often reveal themselves to us through our subconscious during sleep but are most strongly associated and identified through Vision Quests which are accompanied by a Smudging Ritual. Power animals are identified in dreams and vision quests if a particular animal is seen four times during a Vision Quest. A person can possess up to two of the more powerful animal Guardian Spirits or Power Animals, but many of the less powerful plant Spirit Helpers. Power Animals that appears in Vision quests and dreams all have various meanings.

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Me: Even here with this witchcraft you can see how they mention the power animals to be of a higher rank than plant spirit helpers. This is ranking of demons. I have never had an animal appear in my dreams walking around talking like a person or teaching or giving any information to me. This is all demonic. It is happening because the person believes in it and is open to it.

Usually an individual's first vision quest was preceded by a period of preparation with a religious specialist. The quest itself typically involved going to an isolated location and engaging in prayer while forgoing food and drink for a period of up to several days; some cultures augmented <u>fasting</u> and prayer with <u>hallucinogens</u>. In some traditions the

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
There's the pharmakeia again, the idolatry in seeking to evil spirits and the drug use as well helping to facilitate the connection.

Piltzintecuhtli was said to be the son of Oxomoco and Cipactonal (the first man and woman that were created) and was seen as a protector of children. He was identified as the Youthful Sun. Known also as "7 Flower," he was also a god of hallucinatory plants, including mushrooms.



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Native Americans worship the fallen angels and here one of the spirits they worship was called "youthful sun" or "7 flower" - that's a sun god and you can clearly see the link to the hallucinogens they use in their witchcraft.



Vision Quest Potion Powder, there is a recipe here which I blacked out the ingredients. Then it says place the herbs into a mortar and with a pestle grind into a fine powder. Sprinkle the powdered herbs around you, as you lay down relax within a circle of stones beneath the night sky. This is witchcraft plain and simple. The whole process is seeking to higher powers but not to Jesus Who is The Highest power of all. This is idolatry and witchcraft.

Let's finish looking at the definitions tied to the word pharmakeia.

SORCERY

A. Nouns.

1. pharmakia (or -eia) (φαρμακία, 5331) (Eng., "pharmacy," etc.) primarily signified "the use of medicine, drugs, spells"; then, "poisoning"; then, "sorcery," Gal. 5:20, RV, "sorcery" (KJV, "witchcraft"), mentioned as one of "the works of the flesh." See also Rev. 9:21; 18:23.¶ In the Sept., Ex. 7:11, 22; 8:7, 18; Isa. 47:9, 12.¶ In "sorcery," the use of drugs, whether simple or potent, was generally accompanied by incantations and appeals to occult powers, with the provision of various charms, amulets, etc., professedly designed to keep the applicant or patient from the attention and power of demons, but actually to impress the applicant with the mysterious resources and powers of the sorcerer.

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Me: When someone seeks to a power outside of Jesus that is idolatry and the things described here are witchcraft. This is pharmakeia and the witch and the patient are opened to demonic activity.

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

2. Power more than natural.

You might think that is far fetched that my 1800's Noah Webster dictionary said that witches have intercourse with the devil. Not really, they have shown us the truth in movies like *Rosemary's Baby* and *The Entity*. That's probably part of their initiation. Many times people in sexual sins have sex with demons but they think it is just a dream, or they dismiss it because they don't understand it. In order for that to stop, they must be saved, ask forgiveness for their sexual sins and break the soul ties.

By whatever name, all such practices are strongly condemned (Exod. 22:18; Deut. 18:9-14; Sam. 28:3,9; II Kings 23:24; Isa. 8:19; Acts 19:

Go about the middle: Greek pharmakeia (Gal.5:20 ASV, RSV sorcery) means the use of drugs, charms or magic words. Plain and simple here, the use of drugs. But as I have been bringing out it is a certain type of drug, like hallucinogens or alcohol that produced an altered state of mind in order to connect with the demons. Just remember witches use potions, medicines and herbs or drugs like hallucinogens in their witchcraft practices.

This is Romeo paying a visit to the apothecary.



What they call rootwork is considered by those who practice it and those who seek it out as good. Meanwhile, "bad roots" is the use of natural materials – plants, blood, bones, candles, feathers and more – for magical purposes, akin to voodoo.

This is a potion and rituals, spells and incantations will have been done over this product. This does not make the person hallucinate but it opens a door in their lives to the kingdom of darkness just the same.

had witchcraft spells, incantations spoken over it, rituals done etc. Although, this type of thing is along the lines of modern day marketing – who knows what's really in this stuff. But if you participate in this, you are in sin against God and demons will be drawn to you because of it.

How To Make A Potion

Potions get their power from the rituals you do as you make the potion, the symbolism behind the ingredients you choose, and the power of your own mind. Like other practices in witchcraft, there is quite a bit of room for experimentation and personalizing your recipes to fit your specific intention.

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I want you to see that witches do rituals over their potions. Everything a witch does, is outside of God's will for our lives. They are seeking supernatural powers and experiences. A witch wants to control others. God hates witches. (Exodus 22:18) When they stated that the power of their own mind adds power into their potions, that is just non-sense. If there is any power or anything supernatural that takes place it is from the demons and not their "mind power."

Witchcraft and magic

Some pharmacological cults do not rise much above the level of <u>witchcraft</u>, with ceremonies expressing the participants' insecurities, anxieties, and hostilities. This is particularly true of cults operating among a marginal, competitive people, as in the Peruvian <u>cult</u> that uses *ayahuasca* (*Banisteriopsis caapi*). This is a syncretistic cult in which primitive magical beliefs are interwoven with minimal Roman Catholic features. Bad luck is looked on as the result of the curse of an envious neighbour, and the <u>witch doctor</u> is sought to dispel the curse and, if possible, to turn it onto its originator. At other times illness may be interpreted as the result of possession by evil spirits, and the purpose of the ceremony may be exorcism. In all of these cases the visions produced by the drugs, influenced by the assumptions and desires of the participants, will be interpreted according to the hopes and fears, <u>prejudices</u>, and suspicions of those participants.

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Me: This is another example of the drugs used in witchcraft, another example of pharmakeia.

CLOSING

Pharmakeia – sorcery – magic – witchcraft paired with drugs or medicines or spell-giving potions is all about idolatry. They go together. The sorcery spoken of in Rev.18:23 is about connecting people to the fallen angels so that they will be in idolatry against God.

Those who practice pharmakeia are deceived away from knowing Jesus. Demons will interact and even seem to empower the person or enlighten them so that they believe they are interacting with what they believe to be God or a god. All the while they are actually in idolatry against God. They have a different god they are serving, a different spirit or power they are worshipping and that is breaking the first commandment.

Let's read a passage where Jesus was asked about the greatest commandment.

Matthew 22:36-38 - Master, which *is* the great commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.

This encompasses the first three commandments here. We cannot serve and be faithful to God through Jesus if we are serving other Gods. Seeking anyone or anything in the spirit realm except The Lord God Almighty is a deal breaker. God will not accept us if we serve other Gods.

PRAYER

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
