A quick refresher on the church in The Maasai Land:

We had a good time with Pastors and the key leaders. We were welcomed with love and these people for sure love God. It's one of the tribes in Kenya that live in the arid areas, many have no education, still living old traditional life, unreached with the gospel, poor and live a nomadic life. No vehicles we used motor bikes to move into the villages on very dusty roads where the churches are. We now have 4 branch churches under our ministry. I give glory to God.

Where the main church is build it's a rented land. My visitation was fruitful, God touched one of the brothers in church who donated a 4 acre piece of land. Now the leaders decided here is where the headquarters of our ministry will be build for our Maasai land ministry work, it's just next to piped water and a passable road on its lower part. Thank you Jesus!!!

The other 3 branch churches are in different locations in the remote villages.

Pastor Erustus was under a spiritual attack and was kept from going on this mission to the Maasai Land. In fact he has been fought very hard many times when he has planned to go here. On this trip Bishop David, a very close ministry friend of Pastors and Pastor Amos stood in for Pastor Erustus.
