NEW AGE Pt. 33: NEW THOUGHT, LAW of ATTRACTION

Let's take a look at some of the movements that influenced "The I am Movement" and some that splintered out from it or that are very similar to it but let's look at them under their new age names. We've looked at new age teachings about what we speak already, today's focus and next week's focus is going to be on our thoughts and the perverted new age teaching about how to use your thoughts.

NEW THOUGHT MOVEMENT

The New Thought Movement, affirmed the belief in the divinity of each individual. There's the idea of being a god. One of New Thought's major contributions to New Age philosophy is the belief that "thoughts are things," and the idea that positive thinking has the power to change the world. Look at the power being given to and placed on "thoughts."

Back in 2015 in my research I watched a video testimony of a young woman who was involved in New Age. She was involved in and interested in the "The Secret", "Power of Positive Thinking", and teachings by Eckhart Tolle etc. She had just come back from a convention on this type of stuff when one night she heard a man's voice clear as day in her head say: "Illuminati." This scared her and she repented of all of this junk and came back to Jesus. Her video testimony has been removed from Youtube. No surprise there. This is another witness of the bad fruit

that being in New Age produces. These books and teachings like this girl was reading and putting into practice are the same things that Oprah pushes on her show.

Law of attraction and the affirmations they speak of along with positive thinking and creative visualization are all part of the new age manifestation process. Since this isn't Biblical, those that practice it have opened spiritual doors for demons to come and influence their lives.

Affirmations – Thought: Motivation Positive Affirmations, You are magic, I am worthy of what I desire etc. Affirmations in New Thought and New Age terminology refer primarily to the practice of positive thinking and self-empowerment – fostering a belief that "a positive mental attitude supported by affirmations will achieve success in anything."

This reinforces the belief that they are gods. I am worthy of what I desire – that's pretty self centered – Scripture calls that being carnal or fleshly.

LAW of ATTRACTION

Law of Attraction is a philosophy that came from the New Thought Movement. Another name for law of attraction is manifestation or manifesting.

The Law of Attraction is a principle that suggests your thoughts and feelings influence what you attract into your life. It proposes that by focusing on positive thoughts and feelings, you can attract positive outcomes and experiences, and conversely, focusing on negative thoughts can attract negative experiences. Essentially, it's about aligning your energy with your desires to manifest them into reality.

The law of attraction is a principle that suggests your thoughts and feelings influence what you attract into your life. It proposes that by focusing on positive thoughts and feelings, you can attract positive outcomes and experiences, and conversely, focusing on negative thoughts can attract negative experiences. Essentially, it's about aligning your energy with your desires to manifest them into reality.

There is also always the warning to always be paying attention to your thoughts because if you think negative or bad things that's what you are gonna get. You know what, that's some kind of power right there. At least that's what they want you to believe is that you have the power to just manifest whatever you want. It's a money making scheme of the devil and those that fall for it are led away from Christ.

The theme of manifesting your thoughts is layered all through new age teachings. The foundational idea that is tied to that is that you can make it happen because you have the power to manifest what you want. You just have to believe. When they speak of "energy" in new age it is first about the person trying to raise their energy or vibration by focusing and meditating, chanting etc. When they feel these bursts of energy or feel enlightened etc. it is the demonic interacting with them.

*Please play this video – Oprah was on The Larry King show in 2006 sharing about the new age book, "The Secret" and the law of attraction. STOP

She says the message of *The Secret* is the same message she's been sharing on her show for the past 21 years. The message is that you're really responsible for your life. You are responsible for your life. She said she has known this ever since The Color Purple movie role she landed. In 1985 she had a role in The Color Purple. She read the book, *The Color Purple* and that is when she got "the secret." She went out and got books for everybody she knew. She was obsessed about this story. She says she ate, slept and thought all the time about the color purple. Then she gets a call from a casting agent asking her to come and audition for a movie, it turns out it was for *The Color Purple*. She said she had been praying for The Color Purple. She auditions and doesn't hear anything for months. She goes to a "fat farm" thinking she didn't get the part because she was too fat. She weighed 112 lbs at the time. She says she was at the "fat farm" praying and crying to God asking Him to help her to let this go. She is on the track and begins to sing "I Surrender All" and a woman comes out to the track and it's raining and she tells Oprah there's a phone call for her. The phone call was Steven Spielberg telling her to come out and meet with him to talk about the part. She says what she learned from that changed her life. She says she "drew" The Color Purple into her life. She didn't know Steven Spielberg, or Quincy Jones who saw her in Chicago in 1984. He was there over a lawsuit for Michael Jackson about the Thriller album. He saw her on AM Chicago and said, that's Sophia. She says she didn't know him, she didn't know anybody that had anything to do with that. But she knew that she had

drawn *The Color Purple* into her life. It changed the way she thought about her life forever. Larry asks, so you are not surprised by the success of *The Secret*? She said, no, I'm thrilled for the success of *The Secret*. She says she thinks the message needs to go further because she thinks the mistake that was made with *The Secret* is that they tried to let that be the answer to all questions. It's not the answer and law, the law of attraction is one law. There are many laws working in the world. But it is very true that the way you think creates reality for yourself. There are other factors going on, so it's not everything. But you really can change your own reality based on the way that you think. *(about 3.5 min's)

At that time she had been sharing the message of the new age book *The Secret* for 21 years. Now it's been 19 more years that she's been using her platform to teach new age. The book *The Secret* is like one of the new age bibles. She said she ate, slept and thought about *The Color Purple* all the time. There's the emphasis on your thoughts and attracting what you think about. Now she is deceiving people when she says she was out on that track crying and praying to God and singing to Him. These freemasonic new agers have no problem lacing their speech with Christian terms and saying God or Jesus and deceiving the common people to believe that they are actually Christian when they are not. She doesn't care that The Bible says there is only one way to heaven and His name is Jesus. (John 14:6) She is going right on with her own new age teachings and acting as if there are many ways to God, acting as if she has a real relationship with Him when she doesn't. She serves the god of this world but uses Christian words and things to deceive those that cannot discern.

Please understand when she sat there saying she didn't know Spielberg or Quincy Jones etc. – they are all luciferians. They serve the same master. She has gotten to where she is and what she has by serving satan and the fallen angels and not Jesus. There are testimonies online from Jayz, Steve Harvey and others about using *The Secret*. I hope you have eyes to see that they serve a different master even though they lace their speech with Christian words like God or Jesus or

prayer. There is a false Jesus and a true Jesus and you have to look at their life and the fruit they produce to discern who they really serve. No one will be on the world stage that is not benefiting the god of this world in some way.

In the end of it she stated that there are many laws working in the world. The luciferians have their own laws that they adhere to and believe in. They have what they call "laws of nature", the freemasons follow them and so do new agers. They follow those laws and not God's law which is His Word. She ended by saying that you really can change your own reality based on the way that you think.

What she's teaching is that you are the master of your destiny. When you think like that you are not submitted to Christ and that means that you are not under God's umbrella of protection, your life is open to and influenced by the kingdom of darkness.

Let's see what the Bible says about our thoughts:

Matt.6:24-34 – (Jesus speaking here) No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall He not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added

unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day *is* the evil thereof.

The last verse, is saying just focus on one day at a time because the troubles of each day are more than enough to contend with, without worrying what may come the next day or in the future.

New Living Translation

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

New Living Translation – v. 33:

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously and He will give you everything you need.

NLT says can all your worries add a single moment to your life? We all worry about things but where worry becomes a sin is when you don't lift it up to God in prayer. Don't just be worrying to worry. Trust in God and in His Word, He knows our needs. Let's live righteous lives so that we can take Him at His Word knowing He will meet our needs. We don't always get everything we want, but He will meet our needs. We were not told in this verse to get a positive mantra and "think" it over and over so that we can make our needs and the things we want manifest. Instead we are told to live an obedient life and trust God and He will take care of us.

These new age teachings about how to manipulate your thoughts hoping to manifest what you think about are self serving, focused on greed and lust and serving the god of mammon.

We always hear that mammon is money, riches, material wealth and possessions. Did you know mammon is the name of a false god as well.

"mammon" from Syriac – this would be in the region of Mesopotamia which God called Abraham out of. This is the area where Babylon was. The god of this world is called mammon. Mammon was the Syrian god of wealth, similar to Plutus of Greek and Roman mythology.

We know from Scripture that the god of this world is satan. (2 Cor.4:4) Who do the luciferian elites go to for wealth, who does Hollywood go to for wealth, who are the musicians and those on the world stage making a deal with? The devil. That's where they get their wealth, fame, talent and every other thing they have. There are two masters mentioned, the real and true God and satan, a fallen angel. I can see where a lot of people don't think they are serving satan, they don't pray to him or bring him blood sacrifices and things like that.
